KAIROS Prison Ministry

The Kairos ministry to residents in State Maximum Institutions began in the middle 70s and has continued to the present day for both men and women. Organized as a Trinitarian Lay Led Ministry, men and women from Catholic, Baptist, Pentecostal, Methodist, Presbyterian and other denominations participate in the ministry. With their Headquarters in Florida, Kairos Prison Ministry is in 39 states and 10 foreign countries.

Each state has a coordinating body called the Advisory Council (AC). Riverbend Maximum Security Institution (RMSI) in Nashville is the nearest Men's Kairos Prison Ministry. The Women's Kairos Prison Ministry conducts weekends at the Debra Johnson Rehabilitation Center. After the weekends, the team returns to the facility for a reunion time with the residents who have completed a Kairos weekend. It is

called Prayer and Share Time. The residents conduct the activity. The Kairos volunteers are present to encourage and support the residents.

Ministry Manager is the database provided by the Upper Room that retains our Emmaus community information. Ministry Manager a community management application that enables an Emmaus or Chrysalis Community to store and use information to conduct the Emmaus ministries.

Access to the application is based on an individual's unique email address. Each person must have a unique email address to have an account in order to gain access. Access to information within the application is controlled through the assignment of various roles. Role assignments vary from the lowest level of Community Member, to the highest level of data administrator.

Many of us already have an account because we had an email address in the previous database system. Others have been added. However, many of our community members do not have access. Each person added to the Ministry Manager application is




added with their unique email address. After a person's name and email address are added to Ministry Manager, Ministry Manager sends an email invitation to the email address, and the individual responds to the invitation to establish an account.

We, the Baard of Directors, want to improve your access. Our goal is for everyone to have an active account so that we can communicate and share information on a common platform. If you know that you have never logged in to Ministry Manger, or you are unsure if you have an account, contact the database and communications chairperson, Steve Zuercher, at the community email address, nash-villeemmaus@gmail.com, or his personal email address, slzurk@gmail.com as

soon as possible.

If you have attempted to log in and have had difficulty, or are unsure how to navigate in Ministry Manager, contact Steve for assistance.
