

### **MENTORS**



**Mentors** – an experienced and trust advisor; recommended to have at least 5 years experience.

Finding a mentor is an essential tool for a new educator. Mentors can help prepare new teacher for what they may expect as an educator. They also provide a safe harbor when the new teacher has a bad experience or difficulty adjusting.

#### **Types of Mentors**


- Hall Neighbor

- 2 Lunch Breaks
  - Take a Break
  - Get out the classroom
- **3** Work Time is WORK time
  - Be productive and Professional
- 4 Avoid taking work home.




