Rules and Guidelines

HOLOHOLO KALKIMAKA AT KEKUAOKALANI– December 11th 2021

Assembly Time: Event participants should check in at the Kona Kekuaokalani Gym/Pool Complex no later than 4:00PM. We strongly recommend that you use Makala Blvd. to Kuakini Hwy going South to the gym. Vehicles in the event will be directed to their assigned positions. There will be parking available for parade vehicles in the designated areas. Entry via the NORTH GATE ONLY. Entrants may stage at the gym after 12:00PM.

Menchune Food Drive: There will be food donation drop-off area near the front of the pool area. Gates open to the public at 5:30PM.

<u>Parade Vehicle Entry</u>: We strongly recommend that you use Makala Blvd. to Kuakini Hwy going South to the gym. Vehicles in the parade will be directed to their assigned positions. There will be parking available for parade vehicles in the designated areas.

Entry Placement: A parking slot(s) for your entry will be designated at check in.

Decorate: ALL VEHICLES ARE TO BE DECORATED WITH <u>CHRISTMAS LIGHTS</u>! THIS IS MANDATORY. We want everyone to enjoy themselves and show off their Christmas spirit.

Santa: NO SANTA SUITS ALLOWED. Santa has his own entry decorated by HPM.

<u>All Entries:</u> Must be in good taste and suitable for an ohana "family" entertainment event and venue.

Handouts: Handing out of candy is totally allowed. Throwing of candy or objects from the vehicles is strictly not allowed. Entrants ignoring this rule will be directed to pleased abide by the rules by the event marshals. Safety first! Distribution of gifts, merchandise, literature, handouts or political materials must be approved in advance by the committee. Squirt guns or other items potentially dangerous to spectators will not be allowed.

<u>Changes in your Entry</u>: For any changes to your entry prior to event day especially the vehicle counts or any changes please call 808-345-2108. We kindly ask that any changes are done a minimum of 24 hours before the scheduled start of the event.

End of Event: The event will officially end at 7:30PM. No participating entry vehicles are to leave prior to the events end. This is a major safety concern. Marshals will guide entries out at the end of the event safely. The committee appreciates the expertise and the caution taken by your licensed authorized drivers who must be at least 18 years of age.

<u>Eligibility</u>: The parade committee's decision regarding all entrants, their eligibility, placement, and judging is final. Eligibility is based primarily on this being a family friendly *'ohana'* event.

First Aid Kit: Each entry must have their own first aid kit(s). (flashlights are also recommended).
