INTRODUCTION

At STATS Sports Complex, every tournament is built on one promise: Top notch playing conditions, every single game.

Our maintenance protocol ensures safe, consistent, high-performance fields so organizations, coaches, and athletes can compete with confidence.

- 1. MAINTENANCE PROTOCOL
- 1.1 Pre-Tournament Preparation

Field Conditioning (24–48 hours before tournament)

- Full infield groom and level check
- Mound and plate rebuilt and packed
- Outfield grass cut to tournament height
- · Edges cleaned, lines straightened
- Warning track rake and inspection
- Dugouts fully cleaned

Facility Prep

- Restrooms deep-cleaned and restocked
- Lighting system checked
- Concession equipment tested and stocked
- Emergency/first-aid stations restocked
- Signages updated for tournament flow1.2 Daily Tournament Maintenance

Between Games

- Infield drag and re-chalk
- Pitcher's mound repair & packing
- · Batter's box resurfacing
- · Bases checked for firmness and alignment
- · Spot repairs on lip edges
- · Quick debris sweep in outfield
- Dugouts cleaned between team transitions
- 1.3 End-of-Day Maintenance
- Deep infield groom and leveling
- Full dugout and seating area sanitation
- Trash removal across the complex
- Restrooms and concessions cleaned and restocked
- 1.4 Post-Tournament Restoration
- Mound and batter's box rebuild
- Full re-leveling and top-dressing of the infield
- Grass aeration (as needed)
- Edging and lip correction
- Drainage inspection
- Complex-wide cleaning
- Maintenance staff review meeting & field condition report
- 2. FIELD QUALITY CHECKLIST

(Used by STATS staff before every tournament day.)

- 2.1 Infield Surface
- Level, no dips or ridges

- Proper moisture throughout
- Smooth traction (no loose, dusty patches)
- Clean, sharp base paths
- No holes around the mound or plate• Lips properly edged
- 2.2 Pitcher's Mound & Home Plate
- Mound height regulation
- Firm, packed landing area
- Plate packed and even
- Rubber secure
- Fresh clay added where needed
- 2.3 Bases & Lines
- · Bases securely anchored
- Proper distance confirmed
- Foul lines are sharp and visible
- Outfield line markers set
- 2.4 Outfield Grass
- Tournament-cut height
- Even cut, no scalping
- · No holes, divots, or bare spots
- Irrigation completed correctly
- Warning track clear and consistent
- 2.5 Safety & Playability
- No debris on the playing surface
- Fencing is tight and secure

- Gates functioning properly
- Padding intact
- · Dugouts are clean and safe
- Pathways clear for players and families
- 2.6 Facility Operations
- Lights are fully operational (if night play)
- Restrooms stocked and clean
- Concessions stocked and staffed• Trash cans emptied
- Emergency kit stocked
- 3. WHY THESE STANDARDS MATTER
