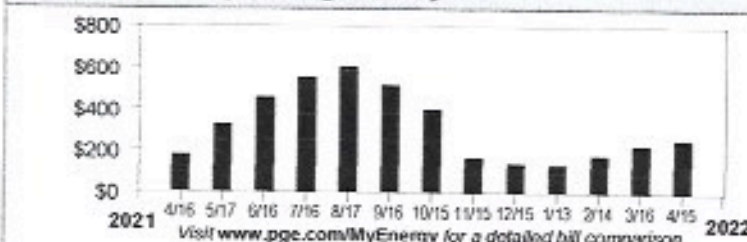

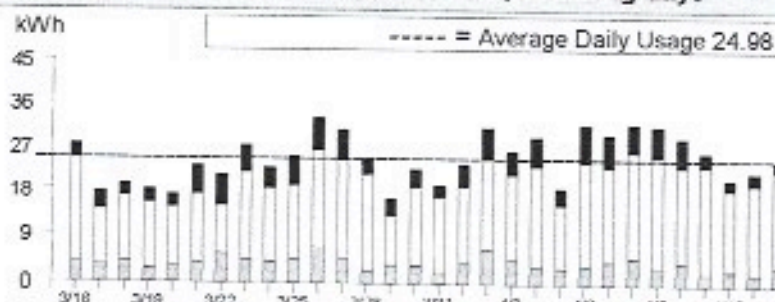

Call 811 before you dig. A common cause of pipeline accidents is damage from digging. If you plan on doing any digging, such as planting a tree or installing a fence, please call **811** at least two working days before you dig. One free call will notify underground utilities to mark the location of underground lines, helping you to plan a safe project.
