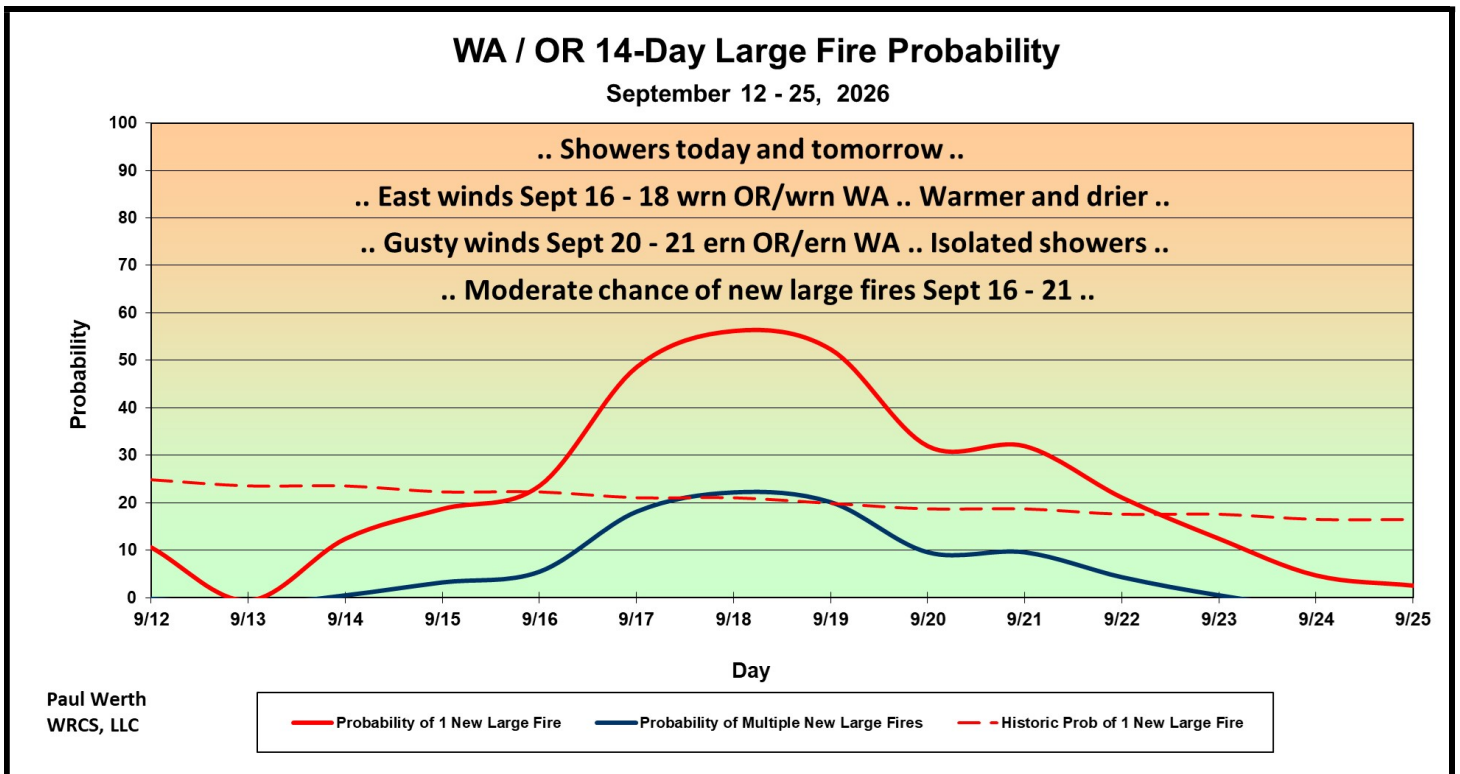


14-Day Large Fire Probability for the Northwest Geographic Area September 12 - 25, 2026

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This product displays the daily probability of new large and multiple large fires in Washington and Oregon for the next 14-day period. The algorithms used to calculate these probabilities are based upon historic 500mb upper level (~ 18,000 ft msl) pressure patterns and observed new large fires. A composite of weather forecast models is used to predict large wildland fire threat for the next two-week period. Large fires are defined as 100 acres (or more) in timber, or 300 acres (or more) in grass. This product has consistently predicted large fire outbreaks 7-11 days in advance of the occurrence over the past 20 years.
