Instructions for Completing the Coach Recommendation for Promotion

(Shodan, Nidan, Sandan)

The Promotion Board is here to help and while some consider all requirements difficult, we have learned with a little time and effort, both the Coach and Applicant will understand why these are important and enhances the credibility of USJA rank and you as the Coach and Applicant.

Head Coach/Examiner Certification

The Head Coach or recommending Coach/Examiner must verify that the applicant has successfully met or exceeded all requirements including TIG since last promotion, number of promotion points for this rank, age, written examination, technical examination, valid background check, valid Safe Sport and Heads Up Certifications. (Refer to Rank Promotion System Manual for details as it contains the information, or you may contact a Certified Rank Examiner or member of the Promotion Board for additional assistance.)

The Head Coach or Examiner certifies that the applicant meets all the requirements for the promotion by completing a written and technical exam, reviewing applicant's judo points history & supporting documentation that records all activities and points since candidates last promotion, including all certifications from other organizations, supplied by the candidate and a review of the candidates' profile on USJA.net.

Carefully review and complete the "Coach Recommendation for Promotion" form. All blanks must be filled in and have the proper sign off. If the form is not complete, we will attempt to contact the coach to help with preparing the needed information before submitting it to the Promotion Board. If the Head Coach/Sensei does not have the rank required to sign off the promotion request, they can have another Coach/Sensei or CRE with the required rank to sign off or contact the Promotion Board for assistance.

Applicant

The applicant is required to maintain their own records for each promotion that includes their activities and the points associated with those activities. These are to be documented on the (Activity Log/Summary Sheet) found on USJA.net. Promotion Points Worksheet. All activities for points must include date, name of activity, points earned using USJA Rank Promotion System guidelines, and a detailed description of the activity to include name of activity, location, host name, competitors name, results of match, name of students coached and outcome of their match, certification/clinic/camp date, topic, sponsor, instructor, etc. The Promotion Board understands that some candidates for one reason or another may not have all the details requested for a specific event. The intent of this requirement is to produce as much evidence as possible explaining the event. Feel free to contact a Certified Rank Examiner or a member of the Promotion Board as they can guide you. You are encouraged to keep a log for this and future activities so you can justify those activities.

The applicant is required to review this with their Head Coach and/or Examiner for verification of points prior to submitting a request for promotion.
