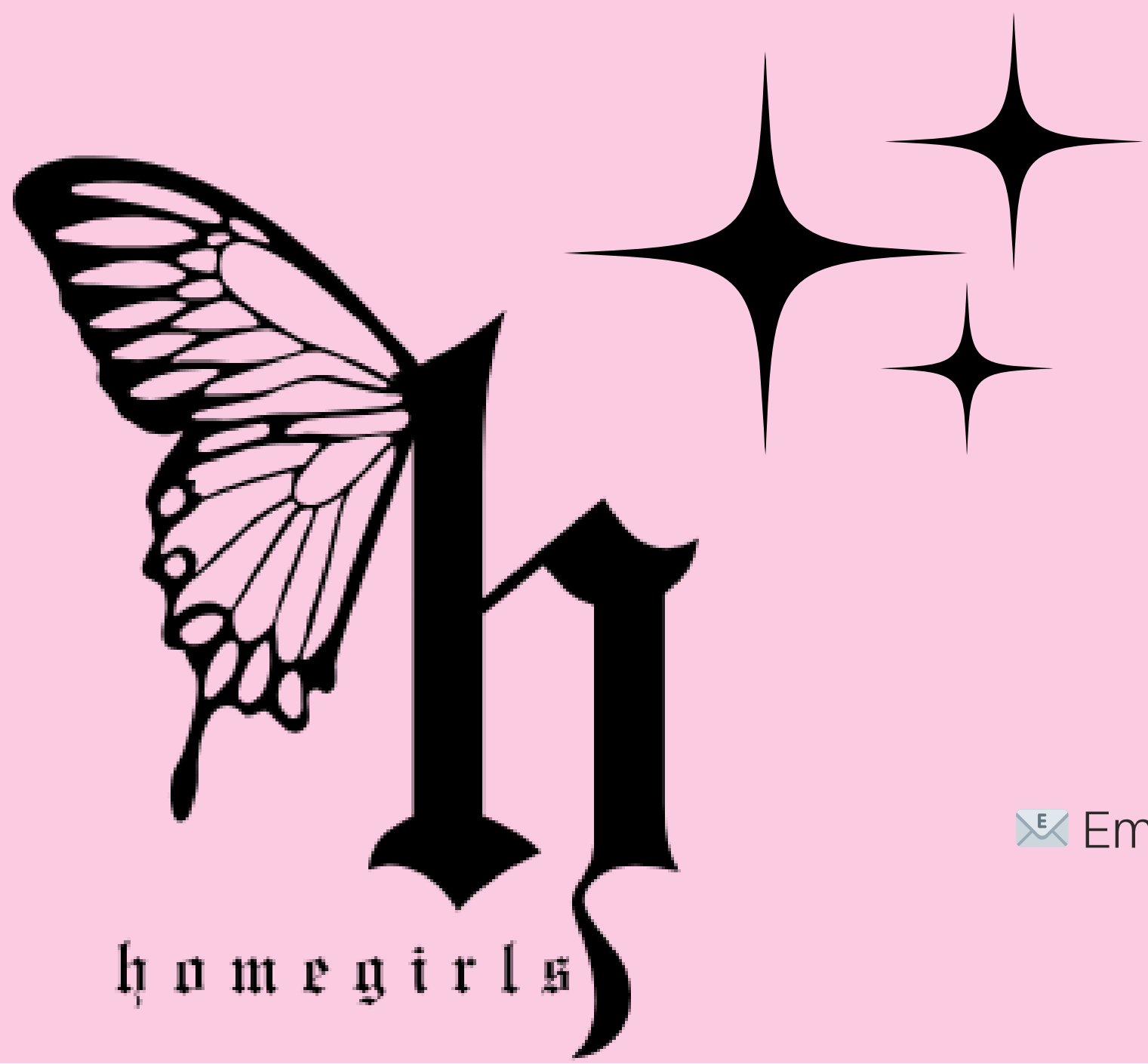
So we're creating a space for our lil homegirls.
