

PAVILION RIBBON CUTTING

Everlasting's commitment to resident enrichment continues with the January 31st ribbon cutting of our long-anticipated Educational Pavilion! A beacon of design and sustainability, the pavilion has integrated energy-efficient climate control systems, sustainable building materials and adaptable spaces that will focus on wellness and education. The grant-funded venture was made possible with American Rescue Plan funding, awarded by the Arizona Health Care Cost Containment System (AHCCCS), and features culinary gardens for aromatherapy, cooking, and nutrition and a welcoming space for fitness classes and walking paths. Guest lecturers and classes will focus on wellness to further enrich the lives of Everlasting residents. Thank you to AHCCCS, FFKR Architects and Kraus-Anderson. Chet



Staff nominated Brian, saying "he's always offering assistance to staff and fellow residents, asking nothing in return." "When maintenance goes out to pull weeds, Brian already has them pulled and in a pile. He also tries to sweep up as well."

When a fellow resident needs something, like a cup of water - and caregivers are with another resident, when they return, Brian is already getting water for them. After all meals, Brian picks up plates and starts cleaning the dishes, stating he "just wants to make the dishwasher's job easier." He's always there when another resident needs help – helping to push a wheelchair or helping to calm others.
