Provincial Disaster Program (PDAP) – Designation Approved

The Rural Municipality of Nipawin No. 487 has received confirmation from the Saskatchewan Public Safety Agency that its request for designation as an eligible assistance area under the Provincial Disaster Assistance Program (PDAP) has been **approved**, for damages resulting from the heavy rain and severe wind event of **July 12, 2026**.

Private Property Application forms are now available for ratepayers who sustained eligible property damage as a result of this storm.

Important Dates

PDAP Registered Disaster Date	July 12, 2026
Claims Must Be Registered with PDAP by	January 12, 2027
Eligible Work Must Be Completed by	July 12, 2027

How to Apply

Ratepayers who wish to submit a claim should:

1. Obtain a Private Property Application form and the Private Property Application Instruction Guide from the RM office, by download from the RM website at www.rmnipawin.ca or by emailing the RM office to request a copy be sent to you.
2. Before applying, contact your insurance agent or broker to confirm whether coverage was available for this type of loss. If coverage was not available, you will need to submit a letter from your insurer, on company letterhead, stating your policy number, the date of loss, the property location, and confirming the denial or lack of coverage and the reasons for it.
3. Complete the application in full, with an **original signature** — PDAP requires original signatures on claim files — and include supporting documentation such as photos and/or videos of the damage.
4. Return the completed original application, with all supporting documentation, to the RM office at P.O. Box 250, Codette, SK S0E 0P0.

The RM office will batch and mail original applications to the PDAP office on ratepayers' behalf. Alternatively, ratepayers may mail their completed original application directly to PDAP at Box 227, Regina, SK S4P 2Z6.

Please note that PDAP is not intended to duplicate insurance coverage or provide full compensation for loss. Assistance is generally limited to the standard replacement value needed to restore essential, uninsurable property to its pre-disaster condition, subject to the maximums and limitations set out in the Provincial Disaster Assistance Program Regulations and the PDAP General Claim Guidelines.
