

BYLAW NO. 3-80

A BYLAW TO REGULATE THE SPEED OF MOTOR VEHICLES WITHIN THE HAMLET OF KIMBERLEY
Saskatchewan enacted as follows:

1. In this bylaw the expression:
 - (a) "public highway" shall have the meaning ascribed to it by The Highways Act, but shall not include a provincial highway as designated in pursuance of such Act;
 - (b) "motor vehicle" shall have the meaning ascribed to it by The Vehicles Act;
2. (a) Subject to 2(b), no person shall operate a motor vehicle at a greater speed than 50 kilometers per hour on a public highway within the hamlet of Kimberley.
(b) No person shall operate a motor vehicle at a greater speed than 30 kilometers per hour on that portion of public highways within the hamlet of Kimberley, designated as playground zones and designated below:
 - i) On Alfred Street from the intersection of Tindall Avenue and Alfred Street to a point of 12 metres north of the said intersection.
 - ii) On Tindall Avenue from the intersection of Alfred Street and Tindall Avenue to a point of 17 metres east of the said intersection.
3. Section 2 shall not apply to the operations of fire engines, and fire department apparatus and vehicles of an ambulance where these vehicles are being operated in emergency duty and employing the siren and flashing red lights.
4. Any person guilty of an infraction of the provisions of this bylaw shall be liable to the penalties in the general penalty bylaw of the municipality.
