

A Bylaw of the Rural Municipality of Nipawin No. 487 to designate the Property known Municipally as Pt. NE 34-49-15-W2nd and Pt. SE 34-49-15-W2nd As being of Architectural, Historical or Natural Value.

WHEREAS Part III of The Heritage Property Act, 1980, authorizes the council of a municipality to enact bylaws to designate real property, including all buildings and structures thereon, to be of architectural, historical or natural value or interest;

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Rural Municipality of Nipawin No. 487 has caused to be served on the owners of the lands and premises known as the Inkster School Site at Pt. NE 34-49-15-W2nd and Pt. SE 34-49-15-W2nd a Notice of Intention to so designate the aforesaid real property and has caused such Notice of Intention to be published in at least two issues of a newspaper with general circulation in the municipality with the first publication at least twenty-one (21) days prior to the date of consideration of the bylaw and with the last publication at least seven (7) days prior to the date of that consideration;

WHEREAS no Notice of Objection to the proposed designation has been served on the secretary/treasurer of the municipality;

THEREFORE, the Council of the Corporation of the Rural Municipality of Nipawin No. 487 enacts as follows:


- 1. There is designated as being of historical value or interest the real property known as The Inkster School Site at Pt. NE 34-49-15-W2nd and Pt. SE 34-49-15-W2nd, and legally described as:

All that portion of the North East Quarter (N.E.¼) of Section Thirty-four (34), In Township Forty-nine (49), In Range Fifteen (15), West of the Second (2nd) Meridian, In the Province of Saskatchewan, in the Dominion of Canada, DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS: Commencing at the South East corner of the said quarter section; thence Northerly along the East boundary of the said quarter section ---181½--- feet; thence Westerly parallel to the South boundary to the said quarter section ---240--- feet; thence Southerly parallel to the said East boundary to the said South boundary; thence Easterly along the said South boundary to the point of commencement.

All that portion of the South East Quarter (SE¼) of Section Thirty-four (34), In Township Forty-nine (49), in Range Fifteen (15), West of the Second (2nd) Meridian, In the Province of Saskatchewan, in the Dominion of Canada, Containing ---0.50--- of an acre, more or less, more particularly Described as Follows: Commencing at the North East corner of said quarter section; thence Southerly along the East boundary of said quarter section ---90 3/4--- feet; thence Westerly parallel to the North boundary ---240--- feet; thence Northerly parallel to the said East boundary to the said North boundary; thence Easterly along the said North boundary to the point of commencement.

The significance of the site is as follows:
Located on the site are the original Inkster School Building and the Inkster School Teacherage.

- 2. The municipal secretary treasurer is hereby authorized to cause a certified copy of this bylaw to be registered against the property described above in the proper Land Titles Office.
- 3. The Secretary treasurer is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this bylaw to be served on the owner of the aforesaid property and on the Minister of Culture and Youth, and to cause notice of the passing of this bylaw.
