

Rural Municipality of Nipawin No. 487
Bylaw #6-2003

A Bylaw to Regulate the Parking of Motor Vehicles


The Council of the Rural Municipality of Nipawin No. 487 in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. In this bylaw the expression:
 - (a) "municipal road" means a public highway that is under the direction, control and management of the Municipality pursuant to Section 206(2)(b) of *The Rural Municipality Act, 1989*
 - (b) "motor vehicle" means a motor vehicle as defined by or pursuant to *The Highway Traffic Act*;
 - (c) "park" shall mean the stopping of a motor vehicle, whether occupied or not, upon a municipal road, otherwise than temporarily for the purpose of and while actually engaged in loading or unloading, or in obedience to traffic regulations, traffic signs or signals, or the direction of a traffic officer or constable, or when necessary to avoid a collision or conflict with other traffic

2. No person shall park a motor vehicle on any municipal road except the following road:

400 metres of municipal road off Highway #35 on
SW 20-50-14-W2nd leading into SE 19-50-14-W2nd

3.
 - (a) A person who contravenes any provision of this Bylaw is guilty of an offence.
 - (b) The penalty for breach of any provisions of this Bylaw shall be those set out in the General Penalty Bylaw of this municipality.
 - (c) Notwithstanding any other provisions of the Bylaw, the owner of any vehicle shall be liable for a violation of any provision of this Bylaw, as well as the person who committed the breach, unless the owner proves to the satisfaction of the judge or justice of the peace trying the case that, at the time of the breach, the vehicle had been stolen from him or taken, without his consent express or implied, out of his possession or out of the possession of a person entrusted by him with its care.
