BYLAW NO 2-2012

A BYLAW TO APPOINT A BYLAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Nipawin No. 487 in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. For the purpose of this bylaw, the expression:
 - a) "Council" means the Council of the Rural Municipality of Nipawin No. 487; and
 - b) "Municipality" means the Rural Municipality of Nipawin No. 487.
2. Council hereby appoints Dennis Squires as the Bylaw Enforcement Officer for the Municipality.
 - o The appointment shall commence May 8th, 2012 and shall continue at the pleasure of council.
3. The appointment may be terminated by Council or by the Town of Nipawin giving 30 days written notice.
4. The duties of the Bylaw Enforcement Officer shall be
 - a) to enforce Bylaw No. 3-2012, A Bylaw Requiring Securing of Loads Transporting Garbage, Refuse or Rubbish, enacted by the council of the Municipality
 - b) to represent the Municipality before a justice of the peace or provincial court judge in the prosecution of anyone who is charged with contravention of Bylaw No. 3-2012, A Bylaw Requiring Securing of Loads Transporting Garbage, Refuse or Rubbish, enacted by the council of the Municipality
 - c) and other duties as may be assigned by council or its delegate
5. The Bylaw Enforcement Officer will be remunerated by the Town of Nipawin.
6. All costs incurred to achieve a conviction will be paid by the Town of Nipawin. All revenues collected by the municipality through voluntary fines and convictions shall be paid by the municipality to the Town of Nipawin on an annual basis.
7. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect on May 8th, 2012.
