BYLAW NO 3-2015

A BYLAW TO PROVIDE SNOW RIDGES AND SNOW FENCES

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Nipawin No. 487, in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. This bylaw shall be referred to as the Snow Ridges and Snow Fences Bylaw
2. In this bylaw the expression:
 - a) "Council" means the council of the Rural Municipality of Nipawin No. 487
 - b) "road allowance" means the area as defined by *The Municipalities Act, 2005*
 - c) "public highway" means that part of a road or road allowance as defined by *The Municipalities Act, 2005*
3. The Council, or its authorized agent, is hereby permitted to enter upon private or crown land adjoining any road allowance or other public highway for the purpose of making snow ridges or erecting a snow fence as a measure to prevent the blocking of roads by snow during winter months.
4. Any person who obstructs or interferes with an agent or servant of the Municipality engaged in carrying out the provisions of this Bylaw, or who destroys, pulls down, alters or interferes with any works carried out or thing done under the authority of this Bylaw, shall be liable on summary conviction to the penalties prescribed by Section 381 of *The Municipalities Act*.
