# RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF NIPAWIN NO. 487

## **BYLAW NO 10-2016**

#### REGULATE THE CONSTRUCTION, MODIFICATION AND MAINTENANCE OF APPROACHES BYLAW OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF NIPAWIN NO. 487

Saskatchewan enacts as follows: Council of the Rural Municipality of Nipawin No. 487, in the Province

### SHORT TITLE

1. This bylaw shall be referred to as the "Approach Bylaw"

### **DEFINITIONS**

- 2. For the purpose of this bylaw the expression:
- "approach" means an improved surface that serves as a private crossing of a municipal right of way (i.e. ditch);
- <u>5</u> "conforming approach" approach; means an approach that is not a non-conforming
- C "culvert" designate, which acts as a conduit for water; corrugated steel, means a sub-surface pipe of Canada 3 G401-M81 approved or any other such material approved by the Foreman or

- j) "road right-of-way" means the portion of the road allowance from the edge of the roadway to the property line of the adjacent property, including shoulder and ditch:

- "shoulder" means that part of a highway immediately adjacent to the roadway and having a surface of asphalt, concrete or gravel, for the use of vehicles;

## GENERAL REGULATIONS

9 The approach shall be material such as organic matter, frozen soil, topsoil, stumps, trees and rocks constructed with clean earth, free from objectionable

10. All approaches shall be constructed:

- a) At least 85 meters away from the centerline of an intersection
- b) At an angle of 90 degrees to the roadway centerline
- <u>c</u> To slope away from the roadway with a grade slope between 5 -6%
- 11. No approach shall be constructed in such a manner as to restrict sight lines or in any way adversely affect traffic safety
- All construction costs or any other costs required to complete construction All construction and all costs of construction are the responsibility of the Applicant. This includes all materials, equipment rentals or purchases, labour of the
- 13. Material from construction of the approach. within the municipal road right-of-way shall not be used for
- 14. The approach shall be constructed with no resulting damage to the road shoulder, road surface, side slopes and/or ditches.
- 15. The Applicant shall be responsible to locate all existing utilities within the rightof-way and ensure that construction does not result in any damage or interference
- 16. Approach must have a minimum top width of 7 meters and 5:1 side construction, as specified in drawing A-A and B-B, attached as Schedule B
- 17. All culverts shall be Canada 3 G401-M81 approved corrugated steel pipe shall meet or exceed the minimum culvert size specified in the written notice of specifications outline in drawing A-A and B-B, attached as Schedule B. Rip rap approval shall be placed to prevent erosion, if necessary. The pipe shall be installed true to grade line and as per installation

# NON-CONFORMING APPROACHES

- 18. Upon identification of a non-conforming approach provided to the land-owner specifying the remedial work that must be carried out. written notice shall be
- If the owner has not completed the remedial work to the satisfaction of the Foreman within 30 days of delivery of the written notice or if, in the opinion of the Foreman there is a transportation or safety conflict, within the shorter period specified in the written notice, the Foreman may order the remedial work to be the remedial work shall be paid by the owner, including a 20% penalty charge done at the land-owner's expense, and all costs incurred by the RM in completing in the opinion of

## CLOSURE OF AN APPROACH

20. Every person who closes an approach shall reinstate, at his or her expense, the being declared a non-conforming approach. shoulder and ditch to RM standards. Failure to do so shall result in the approach

- 22. Where the RM undertakes any construction or reconstruction work that affects a conforming approach, the RM shall undertake any reconstruction of the approach made necessary by the construction or reconstruction at no cost to the owner.


