Shavings are the only approved bedding allowed by the Highland County Fire Marshal.

Note: The fairgrounds will implement a \$900 fine for any bedding used other than shavings.

SHOW SCHEDULE

Friday-May 23, 2024

4 pm: Fairgrounds open to exhibitor arrival

7 pm: Showmanship Clinic (open to all ages & skills). Pizza and drinks will be provided for clinic attendees.

Saturday-May 24, 2024

9 am: Youth Showmanship

12 pm: 3-Ring ADGA Sanctioned Open Jr Doe Show with embedded Youth Show (Ring 1).

6 pm (or ½ hr. past end of Jr doe show): 3-Ring ADGA Sanctioned Open Buck Show.

Sunday-May 25, 2025

9 am: 3-Ring ADGA Sanctioned Open Sr Doe Show with embedded Youth Show (Ring 1).

FEES

Showmanship Clinic (Friday evening): Free

Youth show entries: \$3.50 per head

Youth showmanship: Free

Open show entries: \$7.00 per head, per ring

Pen fees: \$7.00 per pen

- Pens are 4' x 6'
- **Pens will be inspected upon exhibitors leaving the show to ensure they are in the same condition as upon arrival. The fair board assigns penalties for any pens that have been dismantled.**

LATE FEES: Entries submitted on or after Friday, 5/23, will be charged an additional \$2 per head, per ring.

Late fees do not apply for adding animals to existing early entries.

GENERAL FACILITY AND CLUB RULES

1. **Shavings are the only approved bedding, as per the fire marshal's order.** You may pre-purchase shavings in the Showman App when registering; they will be available for pick-up upon arrival at the fairgrounds.
2. Bucks will be housed in the same barns as does. Bucks 5 months and older must be tied.
3. No horned goats allowed.
4. Milk should be disposed of in the designated wash areas only and must be rinsed and drained completely after each use.
5. No alcoholic beverages or illegal substances will be permitted on the fairgrounds.
6. Parents and guardians are fully responsible for their children under the age of 18. Any person or family not exhibiting proper behavior, as judged by the show committee, will be required to leave the Highland County Fairgrounds immediately and will not be permitted to return for the remainder of the event.
7. Fairground buildings not directly associated with the SWODGA SPRING CLASSIC DAIRY GOAT SHOW are strictly off-limits to everyone.
8. No dogs in the barns or show arena at any time.
9. Smoking, open flames, or heat sources are NOT allowed in the barns.
10. SWODGA and/or the Highland Co. Agricultural Society will not be held responsible for loss, damage, or accidents to any person, animal, or personal property at the fairgrounds.

ARRIVAL & CHECK-IN

- Gates will open for exhibitors on Friday, May 23, 2024, after 4:00 pm.
- Animals may be penned without inspection required by the show committee. A veterinarian will perform an inspection of all animals on site on both Saturday and Sunday.
- **NO** arrivals after 10 pm or before 6 am without permission of the show committee.
- The secretary's office will be open for check-in. All animals must be checked in by the times listed below to be eligible to show.
 - Friday 6-10 pm.

- Sunday 6-7:30 am. Senior Does must be checked in by 7:30 am.

ACCOMMODATIONS (Lodging and Food)

1. Food will be provided on-site by the Highland County 4-H. **YAY!**
2. Camping
 - Camping will be available for \$40.00 per night (this includes electricity and water).
 - Campers utilizing any electricity or water will be required to pay camping fees.
 - Camping reservations and fees will be collected in the Showman App or at check-in.
 - Camp permits will be required this year and will be issued by the show committee upon arrival.
 - If you plan to dry camp, please park away from any utility poles. You will be issued a dry-camping permit stating you are dry camping. If utilities are utilized, the exhibitor will be required to pay the camping fee.
 - Campers (including tents) may NOT use electricity from the barns.
3. There are hotels in the Hillsboro area. The club recommends the Hillsboro Days Inn.

HEALTH RULES

1. All animals will be health checked by a DVM and/or by the Health Com. throughout the morning or day (Sat and Sun).
2. Ohio State Health Regulations shall govern. Anyone requiring veterinary services is responsible for any charges incurred.
3. Animals coming in from outside Ohio must have a 30-day health paper for interstate travel. Papers and the animals will be checked in accordance with the Ohio health rules. Health papers should state that "Animals have no signs of Scrapies or Foot & Mouth disease."
4. The veterinarian requires a copy of all out-of-state health papers. You will be asked for a copy at check-in.

OPEN SHOW: RULES AND GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Sanctioned by ADGA: and their rules shall govern. The base age date for animals will be the date of each show.
2. Original registration papers and/or stamped duplicates must be shown to the show secretary at check-in.
3. **Original registration papers are required** on all animals six (6) months of age, "unless ADGA modifies the rules for use of stamped duplicates and we will follow any modifications made by ADGA."
4. Due to future show expenses, sanctioning of specific breeds will be determined by the number of animals being shown. AOP classes will be implemented in the future if certain breeds continue to fall short of sanctioning.
5. SWODGA reserves the right to adjust the show order, if needed, to keep the show running smoothly.

Open Junior and Senior Doe Shows

1. The open doe shows are sanctioned for Alpine, LaMancha, Nigerian Dwarf, Nubian, Toggenburg, AOP, and Recorded Grade.
2. JRs & SRs are separately sanctioned for open doe shows.
3. Judging will be conducted in a sequential order: Ring 1, Ring 2, followed by Ring 3.
4. Show Order: Nigerian Dwarf, Alpine, LaMancha, Nubian, Toggenburg, AOP, Recorded Grade

3. All three rings will begin judging at the same time.

YOUTH SHOW: RULES AND GENERAL INFORMATION

1. The Youth Show will be embedded in Ring 1 of the open show for both Jr. and Sr. does.
2. You must sign up for the youth show separately from Ring 1 if you wish to show in both.
3. All animals in the Youth Show must be in the child, family, herd name, or have an **ADGA-acknowledged lease**.
4. If the child has an animal leased through ADGA, the lease date(s) must include the date of the show.
5. A copy of the lease, along with a dated email confirming that the lease was submitted to ADGA, is required at check-in.
6. The child's name must appear on the entry form to be eligible to show in the Youth Shows.
7. The Youth Show will be sanctioned for the same breeds as the open show. Alpine, LaMancha, Nigerian Dwarf, Nubian, Toggenburg, AOP, and Recorded Grades.
8. Show Order: Nigerian Dwarf, Alpine, LaMancha, Nubian, Toggenburg, AOP, Recorded Grade
9. Class details are the same as the open doe classes/age categories.
10. No Champion Challenge will be offered in the Youth show.
11. Premiums and awards will be offered for both Sr & Jr Doe youth shows:
1st - \$5.00 / 2nd - \$4.00 / 3rd - \$3.00 / 4th - \$2.00 / 5th - \$1.00 / GCH - \$20.00 / RCH - \$10.00 / BDIS - \$25.00

YOUTH SHOWMANSHIP RULES

1. Senior, Intermediate, Junior, and Pee Wee showmanship and Showman of Showman will be offered.
2. No entry fee or pre-registration required.
3. Sign-ups will be available in the Showman App or can be done at check-in or on the day of the show.
4. Showmanship will begin Saturday at 9 am.
5. Age groups and show order will be as listed below. Base age date will be January 1, 2025
 - JR: 8-11 years old
 - INT: 12-15 years old
 - SR: 16-21 years old
 - Peewee: under 8 years old and first-time showers
6. Classes will be placed up to third place. All showmen will receive a ribbon.
7. All first-place winners will receive an Award; second- and third-place winners will receive ribbons.
8. All first-place winners, except those in the Pee Wee division, will compete in the Showman of Showmen classes.
9. The winner will receive a Showman of Showman award.
