HIGHLAND COUNTY FAIR DAIRY GOAT SHOW

SHOW TIME – 8:00AM – SUNDAY, SEPTEMBER 2, 2018

The Highland Co. Agrico Society is sponsoring the Highland County Dairy Goat Show on September 2, 2018 at 8:00am sharp. The Junior and Senior show are separately sanctioned by the American Dairy Goat Assoc. and ADGA rules shall govern. To make the show run smoothly - THE ORDER OF SHOW IS SUBJECT TO CHANGE.

All entrants must submit \$25.00 for an exhibitor’s pass and entry monies along with their completed entry form POSTMARKED by August 20, 2018. Entry fees are \$4.00 per head. You may exchange animals in its breed only.

The fairgrounds will be open for the arrival of animals after 6:00pm September 1, 2018. Animals will be inspected upon arrival. Please have proper papers available before unloading. Please have all animals checked in by 7:00am show day. Animals may be checked in the night before from 5:00pm to 8:30pm in the sheep barn. Check in on show day will be in the Sheep arena from 6:00am to 7:00am. Books will close at 7:00am sharp!

Animals showing signs of infectious diseases or ill health will be immediately barred from the show area. The proper authorities will have the final word in determining a questionable health problem. In case of a dispute, a local vet will be available at OWNERS EXPENSE. The original registration certificate for goats over 6 months or stamped duplicate certificate for all animals under 6 months of age will be required in order to show on show day.

An APPROVED HEALTH CERTIFICATE will be required for all out of state herds. Dairy goats offered for exhibition must be individually identified on the health certificate.

There will be no pre-show milk out. Senior does will show first then junior does.

Order of show will be in alphabetical order with recorded grades showing last.
