The Highland Co. Agriculture Society is sponsoring the Highland County Dairy Goat Show on September 5, 2021 at 8:00 A.M. sharp. The Junior and Senior shows are separately sanctioned by the American Dairy Goat Association and A.D.G.A. rules shall govern. To make the show run smoothly - THE ORDER OF SHOW IS SUBJECT TO CHANGE. All entrants must submit \$30.00 for an exhibitor's pass, and entry monies along with their completed entry form POSTMARKED by August 24, 2021. Entry fees are \$4.00 per head. You may exchange animals in its breed only.

The fairgrounds will be open for the arrival of animals after 6:00 P.M. September 4, 2021. Animals will be inspected upon arrival. Please have proper papers available before unloading. Please have all animals checked in by 7:00 A.M. show day. Animals may be checked in the night before from 5:00 P.M. to 8:30 P.M. in the sheep barn. Check in on show day will be in the Sheep arena from 6:00 A.M. until 7:00 A.M. Books will close at 7:00 A.M. sharp!

Animals showing signs of infectious disease or ill health will be immediately barred from the show arena. The proper authorities will have the final word in determining a questionable health problem. In case of a dispute, a local vet will be available at OWNER'S EXPENSE. The original registration certificate for goats over 6 months or stamped duplicate certificate for all animals under 6 months of age will be required in order to show on show day. However: original registration w/ completed signed transfer, or official ADGA stamped duplicates are required" ADGA RULES PREVAIL

An APPROVED HEALTH CERTIFICATE will be required for all out of state herds. Dairy goats offered for exhibition must be individually identified on the health certificate.

There will be no pre-show milk out. Senior does will show first then junior does.

Order of show will be in alphabetical order with recorded grades showing last.
