Open Showmanship Clinic - Friday- May 24, 2024 @ 7 pm

SWODGA will be sponsoring a FREE showmanship clinic and OPEN TO ALL AGES AND SKILL LEVELS.

The clinic will be presented by Joel Smith. You must provide your animal and must meet health rules. If you are not a show exhibitor, animals must be housed in personal trailers or vehicles; show pens CANNOT be utilized for non-exhibitors participating.

Show Ring Rotation

Each of the 3 rings will start the show at the same time. We hope this will help to alleviate long wait times for breeders and judges but we ask for your patience as this is a new ring management tool for us.

FEES

Showmanship Clinic (Friday evening): Free

Youth show entries: \$3.50 per head

Youth showmanship: Free

Open show entries: \$5.00 per head, per ring

Pen fees: \$2.00 per pen

- Pens are 4' x 6'

- If you dismantled pens for more space, YOU MUST put them back and secure with wire

LATE ENTRIES WILL BE CHARGED AND ADDITIONAL \$2 PER HEAD, PER RING.

CLUB RULES

1. Bucks will be housed in the same barns as does, **bucks 5 months and older must be tied.**
2. No horned goats allowed.
3. **NO DOGS IN THE BARNs OR SHOW ARENA AT ANY TIME.**
4. Milk should be dumped into the wash areas ONL and must be rinsed and drained completely after each use.
5. Southwestern Ohio Dairy Goat Association and/or Highland Co. Agricultural Society will not be held responsible for the loss, damage or accident to any person, animal, or personal property at the fairgrounds.
6. No alcoholic beverages or illegal substances will be permitted on the fairgrounds.
7. **NO SMOKING IN THE BARNs.**
8. Any person or family not exhibiting proper behavior as judged by the show committee will be required to leave the Highland Co. Fairgrounds immediately and will not be permitted to return for the remainder of the two days of shows. Parents/guardians or an adult willing to take responsibility for children/children under 18 are required to control their child/children at all times or proper authorities will be called and ALL will be asked to leave immediately.
9. All buildings not being used for the SWODGA SPRING CLASSIC DAIRY GOAT SHOW are off-limits to everyone.
10. No bedding restrictions.
11. Hay or straw will NOT be furnished. There will be limited hay and straw available for sale on a first come basis for exhibiting during the show only. You may prepurchase hay or straw in the Showman App when registering.
12. Any current CDC and/or local/state guidelines in place at the time of the show will prevail.

ARRIVAL & CHECK-IN

1. Gates will open on Friday, May 24, 2024, at 5 pm. Arrivals must be between 5 and 10 pm.
2. **NO** arrivals after 10 pm or before 6 am without permission of the show committee.
3. The secretary's office will be open for check-in on:
 - Friday 6-8 pm.
 - Saturday 6-8 am. and 11 am-12 pm. Open junior does may arrive after 8 am on Saturday but must be checked in by noon.
 - Sunday 6-8 am. Bucks must be checked in by 8 am.
4. Saturday Youth show goats must be in place and checked in by 8 am.
5. Saturday Open show goats must be in place and checked in by 12 pm
6. Sunday Open show goats must be in place and checked in by 8 am.

ACCOMMODATIONS

1. Camping will be available for \$40.00 per night (this includes electricity and water).
2. Camping is only permitted in the camping area. Campers (including tents) may NOT use electricity from the barns.
3. Food truck(s) will be available on-site but several restaurants are also near fairground facilities. Food truck will offer hot sandwiches, appetizers, and drinks. We also hope to have a coffee truck.

HEALTH RULES

1. All animals will be health checked by a DVM and/or by the Health Com. throughout the morning or day (Sat and Sun).
2. Ohio State Health Regulations shall govern. Anyone requiring veterinary services is responsible for any charges incurred.
3. Animals coming in from outside Ohio must have a 30-day health paper for interstate travel. Papers and the animals will be checked in accordance with the Ohio health rules. Health papers should state that "Animals have no signs of Scrapies or Foot & Mouth disease."
4. The inspecting veterinarian requires a copy of all out-of-state health papers. Please provide the show secretary with a copy at check-in.

SHOW RULES AND GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Sanctioned by ADGA: and their rules shall govern. The base age date for animals will be the date of each show.
2. Original registration papers and/or stamped duplicates must be shown to the show secretary before the start of the show.
3. **Original registration papers are required** on all animals six (6) months of age, "unless ADGA modifies the rules for use of stamped duplicates and we will follow any modifications made by ADGA."
4. **ADGA RULES PREVAIL**
5. Due to future show expenses, sanctioning of specific breeds will be determined by the number of bucks being shown. AOP classes will be implemented in the future if certain breeds continue to fall short of sanctioning.
6. NEW THIS YEAR* Show rotation. Each ring will start the show at the same time.
7. THE ORDER OF THE SHOW IS SUBJECT TO CHANGE if the show committee chooses.

Open Junior and Senior Doe Shows

1. The open doe shows are sanctioned for Alpine, LaMancha, Nigerian Dwarf, Nubian, Toggenburg, AOP, and Recorded Grade.
2. JR's & SR's are separately sanctioned for open doe shows.

YOUTH SHOW: RULES AND GENERAL INFORMATION

1. All animals in the Youth Show must be in the child's or family's or herd's name.
2. If the child has an animal leased through ADGA, the lease must be dated by the entry deadline and a copy of the lease must be for 2024.
3. The lease will be accepted but must show the email date sent to ADGA to be stamped.
4. **The child's name must appear on the entry form to be eligible to show in the Youth Shows.**
5. Breeds that will be sanctioned will be: SR & JR Does – Alpine, LaMancha, Nigerian Dwarf, Nubian, AOP & Recorded Grades.
6. This will be the show order as well. Although **“THE ORDER OF THE SHOW IS SUBJECT TO CHANGE”**.
7. Class details are the same as the open doe classes/age categories.
8. No Champion Challenge will be offered in the Youth show.
9. Premiums and awards will be offered for both Sr & Jr Doe youth shows:
1st - \$5.00 / 2nd - \$4.00 / 3rd - \$3.00 / 4th - \$2.00 / 5th - \$1.00 / GCH - \$20.00 / RCH - \$10.00 / BDIS - \$25.00

YOUTH SHOWMANSHIP SHOW RULES

1. Senior, Intermediate, Junior, and Pee Wee showmanship and Showman of Showman will be offered.
2. No entry fee or pre-registration required.
3. Sign-ups will be done at check-in or day of show.
4. Showmanship will begin Saturday after the conclusion of the youth senior doe show and a break for lunch. The time will be announced at the show.
5. Age groups and order of show will be as listed below. Base age date will be January 1, 2024
JR: 8-11 years old
INT: 12-15 years old
SR: 16-21 years old
Peewee: under 8 years old and first-time showers
6. Classes will be placed up to third place. All showmen will receive a ribbon.
7. All first-place winners will receive an Award: 2nd and 3rd place will receive ribbons.
8. All first-place winners, except Pee Wee, will compete in the Showman of Showman classes.
9. The winner will receive a Showman of Showman award. sponsored by SWODGA. Should this be SWODGA since we're offering sponsorship options via Showman?
