NO POWER LINES MEANS NO WIND FARMS

Have you been wondering what's happening with LAVA RUN Windfarm lately?

The Lava Run developers applied to the Arizona Corporate Commission (ACC) for a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility (CEC) - to build the Lava Run Interconnection Line Project (I-line) a 27 mile x 180' tall high voltage power line to connect the Lava Run Wind Farm to the TEP Springerville Station. On December 3, 2025 the ACC voted. Thanks to the HUGE outpouring of opposition by local residents, the project was SENT BACK to the Line Siting Committee for more local review due to community concerns.

Despite an initial 8-2 vote in favor of the project, the Line Siting Committee must hold another hearing on Feb. 10 in Phoenix on the Lava Run I-Line project to address local concerns. We are making an impact! We are being noticed for our UNITED efforts. We are standing up for our community in OPPOSITION. But, we are not done. We are being asked for our input on the TRANSMISSION LINE ONLY and the negative effects and impacts it brings to the area. More local input has been requested and your chance to speak is NOW!
