

Oppose the Interconnection Line ! HELP STOP LAVA RUN !

The Arizona Corporation Commission (ACC) held an Open Meeting in December to consider the recommendation of its Line Siting Committee to approve Lava Run's application for a 27-mile interconnection line to tie into the power grid at the Springerville Generating Station. The ACC members heard the outcry from all who helped by submitting public comments. Over 150 comments were filed to the docket, and others attended the Phoenix and Hon-Dah hearings in person to voice opposition. The ACC felt they needed more input from Apache County and the Towns of Springerville and Eagar. In the end, the ACC voted unanimously to send it back to the Line Siting Committee FOR MORE PUBLIC INPUT!

MAKE PUBLIC COMMENTS @ SPRINGERVILLE AIRPORT FEBRUARY 9 @ 10 A.M.

The Line Siting Committee has now scheduled another hearing for February 9 through 11 to take more public input. The meeting will be held in Phoenix, but a remote site will be set up at Springerville Municipal Airport conference room to take public comments by Zoom. It will be the first agenda item on February 9 @ 10:00 a.m. Let's pack the airport and make public comments OPPOSING THE INTERCONNECTION LINE! *Without approval of the Interconnection Line, the Lava Run Wind Project is dead!*

ALSO SUBMIT A WRITTEN COMMENT...

Written comments are recorded in the Docket as part of the Interconnection Line case and will be seen by the ACC members when the Line Siting Committee re-votes and sends a revised recommendation to them. So it's a good idea to also submit a written comment. And urge others to make one, too. It's simple:

- Log in to azcc.gov. Under Divisions, select Utilities.
- Scroll down and select Public Comment Form
- Fill out the form using the Company Name box. The name is **CG Apache County Wind LLC**. As you start to enter the name, a pop-up screen will appear under the box with the company name listed. Select it and the docket number should automatically fill in. The docket number is **L-21364A-25-0198-00250**.
- There are two ways to submit a comment:
 1. Either enter your comments in the box provided. Note that your comment will appear as one big paragraph with no paragraph breaks, which is hard to read if you have a lot to say.
 2. Or prepare the comment in advance, save it as a pdf file and upload by using the "+ Add Files" feature.

Be sure to use the words "Interconnection Line" in your oral and written public comments. This is what they are approving or denying, not the Wind Farm.
