1. Name

The club's name shall be St Mungo's Celtic Supporters Club (CSC)

2. Aims and Objectives

- To support Celtic Football Club both home and away.
- To promote friendship, respect, and community spirit among supporters.
- To organise travel, tickets, and social events for members.
- To represent the values and traditions of Celtic FC and its charitable roots.
- To promote inclusion and ensure a welcoming environment for all supporters.

3. Membership

- Membership is open to all Celtic supporters who share the Club's values.
- Members must pay an annual membership fee as determined at the A.G.M.
- All members agree to abide by the Club's constitution and code of conduct.
- The Committee may revoke membership for behaviour bringing the Club into disrepute.

4. Committee Structure

The Club shall be managed by a Committee elected at the Annual General Meeting (AGM). Roles include:

- Chairperson – Oversees meetings, represents the Club publicly.
- Secretary – Maintains records, correspondence, and minutes.
- Treasurer – Manages finances and presents annual accounts.
- Bus Convener – Organises transport to matches.
- Social Media Officer / Webmaster – Manages online presence and website.
- General Committee Members – Assist with various tasks.

5. Meetings

- An AGM will be held annually with 28 days' notice to members.
- Committee Meetings will take place as needed.
- An Extraordinary General Meeting (EGM) may be called by 25% of members or the Committee.

6. Voting and Quorum

- Each full member has one vote at general meetings.
- Decisions are made by majority vote; the Chairperson has the casting vote in a tie.
- A quorum is 50% of the Committee for meetings and 20% of members for AGMs/EGMs.

7. Finances

- All Club funds will be used to support the Club's aims.
- The Treasurer must keep accurate financial records.
- An annual financial report will be presented at the AGM.
- The Treasurer is the sole signatory on the Club's account and is responsible for all withdrawals and payments.

8. Code of Conduct

- Members must act respectfully and responsibly.
- Abusive, discriminatory, or violent behaviour is not tolerated.
- Members represent the Club and Celtic FC at all times.

9. Amendments to the Constitution

Amendments must be submitted in writing to the Secretary.
Changes require a two-thirds majority vote at an AGM or EGM.

10. Dissolution

If the Club dissolves, remaining funds will be donated to a Celtic-aligned charity, as chosen by the members.
