

# ENYYSA STATE CUP/CHALLENGE CUP COMPETITION REFEREE ASSIGNMENT/INFORMATION

THESE ARE SINGLE ELIMINATION TOURNAMENTS AND CANNOT END IN A TIE

## ASSIGNMENTS

Referees shall accept **ASSIGNMENTS** to officiate at games only from the Referee Assignor or Designee. Referees shall accept **GAME CANCELLATIONS** only from Referee Assignor or Designee or Age Group Commissioners (**no cancellations are to be accepted from any coach**).

## PRE-GAME DUTIES

Referees are to call coaches to confirm game Thursday prior to the match.

Referees are to **collect their fee prior** to commencement of the game

1. Referees must arrive at the field of play one-half hour before the kick off time to check eligibility
2. Teams have been notified to Print and bring:
  1. 2 copies of the **Match Card (with Photos)** printed from the online registration system within 48hrs of the scheduled game time
  - OR--
  2. 2 copies of the **stamped ENY State / Challenge Cup roster** (received via email) AND 2 copies of the **Match Card (standard)** printed from the registration system within 48hrs of the scheduled game time

## GAME RESPONSIBILITIES

The Referee shall be the supervisor and the timekeeper for every game, the sole judge of all matters pertaining to, and or any nature connected with the game, and are the direct representative of ENYYSA on the field.

### **TIE BRAKERS- KICKS TAKEN FROM THE PENALTY MARK –**

“Kicks taken from the Penalty mark will be conducted in accordance with LAW 10, paragraph 3” (see separate attachment)

Only players on the field of play at the end of the second overtime period are allowed to participate.

Five (5) players from each team are selected by their Coach to take this type of kick (commonly called a penalty kick), alternating with five (5) players from each team.

1. The Referee shall toss a coin and the team that wins the toss shall decide which goal to be used for the kicks.
2. The Referee shall toss a coin, and the team whose captain wins the toss shall decide whether to take the first or second kick.
3. (a) Subject to the terms of the following paragraph (c) and (d) both teams shall take five (5) kicks.(b) The kicks shall be taken alternately.(c) If, before both teams have taken five kicks, one has scored more goals than the other could, even if it were to complete its five (5) kicks, the taking of kicks shall cease. (d) If, after both teams have taken five (5) kicks, and both have scored the same amount of goals, the taking of kicks shall continue on a one to one alternating basis (not necessarily five (5) more kicks each) until such time that one team has scored one goal more than the other team after both teams have taken an equal number of kicks. No player is to take a second kick until all players, including the goalkeepers, of the teams on the field of play at the end of the second overtime.

## ***SUBSTITUTIONS –***

***For all age groups participating in the Challenge Cup, unlimited substitutions shall be allowed.***

***For all age groups participating in the ENYYSA State Cup***

For the U12 to U14 age groups, unlimited substitutions shall be allowed. For all other age groups, a maximum of 7 substitutions for each team shall be allowed in each game during each half of play and during overtime play. After leaving the game during a half of play, the substituted player may not re-enter the game during that same half of play. After leaving the game during overtime play, the substituted player may not re-enter the game.

If a player is suspected of suffering a head injury they may be substituted for evaluation without the substitutions counting against the teams total number of allowed substitutions during each half or overtime period. If the player with the suspected head injury has received clearance from the events "Health Care Professional, the player may re-enter at any stoppage of play. The evaluated player must replace the original substitute and will not count as a substitution. The temporary substituted player may re-enter the game as a regular substitute. A team may only make a temporary substitution if they have a substitution available.

***For all age groups participating in the ENYYSA State Cup and the ENY Challenge Cup***

Substitutions may be made only with the consent of the Referee, at any stoppage in play.

A substitute is **NOT** allowed for a player sent off (ejected) from the field of play by the Referee.

A player shall **NOT** leave the field of play or enter onto it without the consent of the Referee.
