AWARD CRITERIA

Scholarships awards will be determined by the criteria identified below. Awards will be made without regard to age, gender, race, creed, color, or national origin: Applications will be scored based on the following criteria, listed below in priority order:

- 1. Academic Achievement
- 2. Extracurricular Activities
- 3. Personal Statement
- 4. Recommendation Letter
- 5. Financial Need

SCHOLARSHIP AWARD:

- Students will be notified by Friday, April 25, 2025, if they have been selected. Scholarships will be publicly announced at the Senior Recognition Ceremony on Thursday, May 8, 2025.
- Scholarships will only be paid directly to the school for tuition, and/or room and board.
