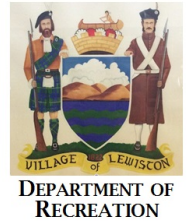

Weekly Activities – September 6th - December 31st

Toddlers and Preschoolers - Ages 0-5 - Thursdays 9:30–11am. Let your child socialize with other children, drawing and do a craft. Cookies and juice provided. Donation of \$1.00 per child for the refreshment. (No session 11/23, 12/28)

Afterschool Program - Ages 8-13 - Monday–Friday 3:30-5:30pm Saturday 9:00am-11:00am - This is a time of recreation and fun. Experience playing basketball or games in the gym, playing pool, foosball or ping-pong in the game room, or arts and crafts. Free. Sessions could be cancelled due to ongoing events.

Evening Open Basketball Hours - Ages 14-19 - Monday-Thursday 5:30-8pm and Saturdays 11:00am-2pm - The gym is open for basketball and the game room open for friendly games of Ping-Pong, foosball and pool. Free. Sessions could be cancelled due to ongoing events or elections.

Fitness Center/Weight Room - Ages 16 and up - Monday-Thursday 3:30-8pm, Friday 3:30-7pm and Saturday 9am-2pm - Two rooms of weight equipment for those wishing to tone or build muscles. We also have 2 treadmills and a recumbent stationary bike for the public to use. Free. (Under 18 need parental permission).

Family Gym – Friday Evenings – 4:00-5:30pm - This is a great opportunity for parents to interact with their children in the gym. Children have to be at least 5 years of age and must be supervised by a parent. Sports equipment available. Some family gym dates may be preempted because of upcoming events. No session 10/13, 11/10, 12/1.

Girl's Basketball – Grades 6-9 - September 30 – October 28 Saturdays 1:30-3pm - Looking for girls who like basketball. We plan to start with the basics and then go to games.
