SUPPORT FOR VETERANS' MEMORIAL IMPROVEMENTS AND CREATION OF LEWISTON'S CIRCLE OF HONOR

Whereas: The Village of Lewiston has proudly provided its property at Academy Park to honor local veterans who have courageously served in defending our freedoms, and

Whereas: The current memorial, created and jointly maintained by Lewiston's Veterans of Foreign Wars Downriver Post 7487, and the Village of Lewiston, is in need of improvements that will enhance the readability of the veterans' names, create a safer and more prominent eternal flame, and upgrade the memorial's presence as a place of honor and distinction, and

Whereas: In an effort to be more inclusive and to insure that no veteran's service is forgotten, the VFW has modified its policy to allow names on the memorial to include any and all veterans who have been born in Lewiston, or lived, attended school or worked in Lewiston, and who have served our community and our country since the American Revolution, and

- 10. A motion to approve the Senate Bill S8019A signed by Governor Cuomo on August 4, 2108 effective January 1, 2019. This bill exempts the cost of volunteer firefighter enhanced cancer disability benefits from the fire district budget spending limitation. This bill requires any fire district, department or company in New York that has eligible volunteer firefighters to show proof of insurance coverage that meets the requirements of law or show satisfactory proof of the ability to pay such compensation to ensure adequate coverage for all eligible volunteers.

The proposed cost to the Village of Lewiston to cover Lewiston Fire Company No 1 (with 20 eligible members) is \$2,740.00 through VFIS NY Cancer Coverage.
