(501c3) is applying to the Niagara river Greenway with a grant application to assist in the renovation of the legacy Military Movie theater in Fort Niagara State Park into a performing Arts center through a public/private partnership under the New York State Parks Adaptive-Reuse criteria. This structure is located in the center of the Fort Niagara State park within the boundaries of the Niagara River Greenway corridor adjacent to the Niagara River Greenway trail system. The emphasis of the project is to offer a venue to support education, entertainment, assembly and interpretive opportunities within the park and for surrounding communities.

THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Village board of the Village of Lewiston hereby does approve and endorse the Greenway Application for the assistance of the renovation of the legacy Military Post theater projected by Niagara Post Theater Inc. This project exemplifies the vision, principles, goals, focus and intent of the Niagara River Greenway Plan. The effective use of an existing State resource gives rise to economic opportunities for the region and is an excellent use of the funds associated with community well-being and development.
