Unacceptable **Items**

- Garbage and food waste
- ·Wood pallets or construction lumber
- Yard Waste such as grass clippings, leaves, and tree or plant branches

REFUSE & RECYCLING

Please do not place your refuse for collection earlier than 5:00 PM prior to your designated day of collection and no earlier than 24 hours prior to the first Monday of the month collection.

Trashcans must not exceed 60 lbs. Violators will be cited. Leaves must be bagged after December 1. Grass Clippings must be set to the curb in plastic bags all year.

ELECTRONICS RECYCLING

FIRST MONDAY OF THE MONTH PICK-UP:

Appliances - Refrigerators & Air conditioners with Freon removed.

Metals - Pipes, scrap etc. (not to exceed 6 ft. in length)

Brush - Branches & trees (not to exceed 6 feet in length) Please do not put out on your regular

Please separate brush, garbage, metal, etc.

If a contractor does the work/service, the contractor is responsible for the removal of the waste.
