

REFUSE & RECYCLING

Please do not place your refuse for collection earlier than 5:00 PM prior to your designated day of collection and no earlier than 24 hours prior to the first Monday of the month collection. Trash cans must not exceed 60 lbs. or be larger than 32-gallon cans. Violators will be cited. Leaves must be bagged DEC1- OCT31 Grass Clippings must be set to the curb in plastic bags all year.

FIRST WORKING MONDAY OF THE MONTH

PICK-UP:

Appliances - Refrigerators & Air conditioners with Freon removed.

Metals - Pipes, scrap etc. (not to exceed 6 feet in length)

Brush - Branches & trees (not to exceed 6 feet in length). Brush must be parallel with road edge.

Furniture - Large items

Please separate brush, garbage, metal, etc.

If a contractor does the work/service, the contractor is responsible for the removal of the waste.

Motor Oil - is accepted at the Village Garage, 892 Seneca Street, Lewiston, NY.
