All weigh-ins will be held at the Michigan Golden Gloves Center; 526 Broadway Ave., NW, Grand Rapids, MI 49504 (downstairs). The Tournament Director may make exceptions to the weigh-in requirements in cases

deemed to have extenuating circumstances.

DRAW/BRACKETING: Following the completion of registration and weigh-in April 13, 2022, draw and bracketing will be conducted

by tournament staff members. Brackets will be available on Saturday, April 16th after 5:00 p.m.

MATCHMAKING: Youth and Junior matchmaking will be done with coaches.

ADVANCEMENT: Senior/Elite **Champions and Runner-ups**, Male & Female, Novice and Open classes qualify to advance to

the State Championships on May 20th & May 21st.

ENTRIES: Completed entry forms must be hand carried to the initial weigh-ins dates (Saturday April 9th between 12:00

PM – 5:00 PM or Wednesday, April 13th 6:00 PM – 8:00 PM. Coaches must complete a Coaches Information Form. These forms must also be turned in at the weigh-in with your USA Boxing Passbook. **Please duplicate**

forms as needed.

PHYSICALS: 5:00 PM each tournament date only boxers fighting that day (at the DeltaPlex)

SHOW TIMES: 7:00 PM each tournament date (at the DeltaPlex)

REPRESENTATION: Boxers must represent a current USA Boxing member club or box unattached

USA BOXINGAll tournament participants must be a current USA Boxing member. (**Boxers, coaches, and official must**

have current passbooks.) All coaches and officials must have attended a certification clinic, taken "Safe Sport Training" and passed a background check as required by USA Boxing before they can receive their

passbook.

2022 WEIGHT DIVISIONS: NOVICE & OPEN: Male: 112, 125, 139, 147, 156, 165, 176, 189, 203, 203+.

Female: 106, 114, 125, 132, 139, 146, 154, 165, 178, 178+.

(THESE ARE MAXIMUM WEIGHTS. NO WEIGHT ALLOWANCE WILL BE GIVEN!!)

BOUT/ROUND LENGTH: Three (3) Two (2) minute rounds for Novice, Male & Female; three (3) three (3) minute rounds for Open,

Male & Female; matched bouts as agreed by coaches

CLASSES:

Elite Male and Female: Boxers 18 thru 40 years of age. (Boxers must be at least 18 at the start of the tournament but not yet 41 on August 20, 2022).

Elite Novice: Male & Female boxers with 10 or fewer bouts who do not meet the experience level to be an Open boxer as stated below:

Elite Open: Boxers with more than 10 bouts. NOTE: Any Boxer who has won their 5th bout as a Youth or Elite boxer, whether they have 10 bouts or not, must box Open. Any Junior or Youth boxer who has won a recognized national championship at ages 13 through 17 must box Open when they become an Elite boxer. The number of bouts of experience shall be counted continuously throughout the boxer's career without interruption. A boxer shall have the option to move to the Open class at any time. However, once a boxer moves up, they may never revert back.

<u>Juniors & Youth:</u> Boxers 8 through 17 years of age, who have not yet reached their 18th birthday by the start of the tournament, may participate on a match making basis. Pre-matches will be made by coaches and tournament officials Matched bouts may be contested as fill-in bouts throughout the Tournament. Contestants in matched bouts are not eligible for advancement in the tournament.

Each participating boxer and coach will receive an event pass/credential which is good for all dates of the tournament. Boxers and coaches will receive their event pass/credentials upon completion of mandatory registration and weigh-in.

BOTH BOXERS AND COACHES MUST BE USA BOXING CURRENT REGISTERED MEMBERS AND COACHES HAVE ALL REQUIRED CERTIFICATIONS UP TO DATE.

Coaches this means you must be registered, have a minimum green level coaches' certification, be Safesport certified and have your background check completed. Coaches event passes/credentials will be issued only after receipt of a Coaches Passbook and a completed Coaches Information Form. No coaches forms will be accepted or passes issued after the mandatory weigh in and registration dates and times.

All participants must present their event pass/credentials at the "pass door" each date for admission (The Pass Door opens at 5:00 p.m.) Please hang on to your own event pass/credential! If your event pass/credential is lost, forgotten or stolen; it will not be replaced. It will be up to you to pay admission from that time on (No pass - No admittance...all others must have an admission ticket.)

BOXERS APPEARANCE:

As specified in the USA Boxing Official Rule Book. Boxers with infractions of the grooming rules will not be allowed to weigh-in.

UNIFORMS/EQUIPMENT:

All participants must provide their own uniforms & mandatory equipment including hand wraps as specified in the USA Boxing Official Rule Book. Coaches must have their own corner equipment. Boxing gloves will be provided. Golden Gloves boxers 139 lbs. or less may wear 10 oz. gloves; boxers over 139 lbs. may wear 12 oz. gloves.

RULES:

USA Boxing rules with Golden Gloves rule exceptions will be used in the conducting of this tournament. Additional Golden Gloves policies & procedures as contained in Golden Gloves of America constitution and by-laws shall prevail over this tournament.

MEDICAL BILLS:

We are not responsible for medical or dental bills. The limit of your medical and dental coverage is that of those paid by USA Boxing insurance. These expenses will be paid only when the injury is properly reported and the necessary forms are completed in a timely manner. (See USA Boxing for additional information.)

AWARDS:

Outstanding awards will be presented to the champion in each weight division of each class. Runner-ups will receive silver medals. **NOTE:** Uncontested champions will receive a gold medal. Each matched bout contestant will receive a momentum for their participation. Special awards will also be presented (Golden Gloves takes pride in presenting the finest awards given anywhere in amateur boxing).

ARTICLE X RULES CONCERNING THE CONDUCT FOR THE GOLDEN GLOVES TOURNAMENT OF CHAMPIONS


A boxer may compete in only one progressive Golden Gloves Franchise Tournament per year.
 Note Local officials may reinstate a defeated boxer for subsequent tournaments if the champion in the same weight class is unable to continue to the next tournament.

Article X,2)

"A Boxer must compete in the Golden Gloves territory where he is domiciled. Proof of which shall be a valid Driver's License, State ID, Voter Registration Card, School Registration, or Military ID. Deviation from this rule may only be done in extenuating circumstances and must have written approval of the Franchises involved with copies provided to the Territorial Committee Chairman and the Executive Director stating the reason for the deviation," at least 20 days prior to the start of competition.

Bill's extreme knowledge of the sport of boxing and his dedication to help in the overall operations gained him a respected seat on the Board of Directors. In April 2014, Bill was inducted into the Robert C. Todish Michigan Golden Gloves Hall of Fame.



Bill was not only a boxing enthusiast, but he was very passionate about the importance of education and wanted to ensure that the area youths had a fair chance of becoming successful.

- 4) The Boxer must continue to participate in the Golden Gloves while receiving the Scholarship.
- 5) The Boxer must be entered in the current Michigan Golden Gloves Tournament (East Mich., West Mich., or State).

FINAL APPROVAL/DISTRIBUTION OF SCHOLARSHIP AWARD IS DEPENDANT UPON RECEIPT OF OFFICIAL TRANSCRIPTS AND/OR A STATEMENT OF ACCEPTANCE ON OFFICIAL LETTERHEAD FROM THE COLLEGE, UNIVERSITY OR TRADE SCHOOL THAT THE BOXER PLANS TO ATTEND. VERIFICATION OF GOOD ACADEMIC STANDING FROM THE SCHOOL MUST BE PROVIDED FOR BOTH SEMESTERS. THIS SCHOLARSHIP IS VALID FOR THE UPCOMING 2022 ACADEMIC YEAR.
