PARTICIPANTS: USA Boxing registered athletes. Elite (ages 18 – 40), Novice, Open. Youth, Juniors and Masters can participate on a matchmaking basis but will not be in an advancing bracket.

REGISTRATION/WEIGH-INS: **REGISTRATION PROCESS – BOXERS & COACHES MUST BE CURRENT WITH USA BOXING:**

Boxers:

Boxers must register by one of the following methods on or before February 29, 2024:

1. **PREFERRED METHOD** – Boxer Registration link located on Michigan Golden Gloves website (<https://michigangoldengloves.com/>)
2. By US Mail to PK Boxing or in person at PK Boxing – 652 28th Street, SW – Suite B – Wyoming, MI 49509. Boxer registration forms are available for download on the Michigan Golden Gloves website (<https://michigangoldengloves.com/>) or at PK Boxing.

(BOXERS - YOU MUST DECLARE YOUR DIVISION AND WEIGHT CLASS AT THE TIME OF REGISTRATION. IF YOU DO NOT MAKE THE DECLARED WEIGHT ON MARCH 9TH WHICH IS THE INITIAL WEIGH-IN DATE, YOU WILL ONLY BE ALLOWED TO CHANGE TO A DIFFERENT WEIGHT CLASS IF THERE IS SPACE AVAILABLE.)

Coaches:

Coaches, must register by one of the following methods on or before March 9th:

1. **PREFERRED METHOD** – Coaches (non-athlete) Registration link located on the Michigan Golden Gloves website (<https://michigangoldengloves.com/>)
2. Coaches (non-athlete) entry forms will also be available at the initial weigh in date (March 9th).

WEIGH-IN PROCESS:

All weigh-ins will be held at the Michigan Golden Gloves Center; 526 Broadway Ave. NW, Grand Rapids, MI 49504 (downstairs).

IMPORTANT: Boxers and coaches must bring in their current USA Boxing Passbooks to the initial weigh-in on March 9th. Duplicate or new Passbooks will not be made or provided at the Weigh-ins. Therefore, if you don't have your passbook, you will not box!

The weigh-in schedule times are as follows:

2024 TOURNAMENT DAILY WEIGH-IN TIMES:

Saturday	March 9 th	9:00 AM-11:00AM	All boxers entered into the tournament must weigh in
Wednesday	March 13 th	10:00 AM-Noon	Only boxers scheduled to fight on this day must weigh in
Saturday	March 16 th	10:00 AM-Noon	Only boxers scheduled to fight on this day must weigh in
Friday (State Semi-Finals)	March 22 nd	10:00 AM-Noon	All boxers that have advanced to state finals must weigh in
Saturday (State Finals)	March 23 rd	10:00 AM-Noon	Only boxers scheduled to fight on this day must weigh in

The Tournament Director may make exceptions to the weigh-in time requirements in cases deemed to have extenuating circumstances.

EVENT PASSES/ CREDENTIALS:

EVENT PASSES/CREDENTIALS:

Boxers that have successfully entered into the tournament and weighed in on March 9th will receive an event pass (credential) which will be valid for the entire 5-day tournament event. If the event pass is stolen, forgotten or lost, it will not be replaced.

Coaches that have successfully entered into the tournament and documents have been reviewed by the administrative staff will receive an event pass (credential) and wrist band which will be required to be worn each day in order to work the boxers corners.

DRAW/BRACKETING: Following the completion of official weigh-ins on March 9th, draw and bracketing will be conducted by tournament staff members. Initially the brackets will be posted to the Michigan Golden Gloves Association Facebook page. After March 10th, the brackets will be available on the Michigan Golden Gloves website (<https://michigangoldengloves.com/>).

MATCHMAKING: Youth, Junior and Masters matchmaking will also be conducted by tournament staff.

ADVANCEMENT: Elite **Champions and Runner-ups**, Male & Female, Novice and Open classes qualify to advance to the State Championships which will be held on March 22nd and March 23rd. **(ONLY STATE CHAMPION ELITE OPEN BOXERS WILL ADVANCE TO THE GOLDEN GLOVES OF AMERICA TOURNAMENT OF CHAMPIONS HELD IN DETROIT, MICHIGAN)**

REPRESENTATION: Boxers must represent a current USA Boxing member club or box unattached

USA BOXING REGISTRATION: All tournament participants (boxers, coaches, officials, and doctors) must be a **current** USA Boxing registered member in good standing and must possess a USA Boxing passbook.

2024 WEIGHT DIVISIONS: **NOVICE & OPEN:** Male: 112, 125, 132, 139, 147, 156, 165, 176, 203, 203+
Female: 110, 119, 125, 132, 139, 146, 154, 165, 178, 178+
(THESE ARE MAXIMUM WEIGHTS. NO WEIGHT ALLOWANCE WILL BE GIVEN!!)

BOUT/ROUND LENGTH: Three (3) Two (2) minute rounds for Novice, Male & Female; three (3) three (3) minute rounds for Open, Male & Female; matched bouts as agreed by coaches

CLASSIFICATION: **ELITE (MALE & FEMALE):** All boxers MUST have reached their 18th birthday by the start of the Michigan Golden Gloves Tournament (March 9, 2024). Boxers over the age of 40 at the start of the Michigan Golden Gloves Tournament are classified as Masters.

ELITE NOVICE: Male and Female boxers with 10 or fewer bouts or no more than five (5) consecutive wins.

ELITE OPEN: Boxers with more than 10 bouts. Any boxer who has more than five (5) consecutive wins as a Youth or Elite boxer, whether they have 10 bouts or not, must box Open. The number of bouts of experience shall be counted continuously throughout the boxer’s career without interruption. A boxer shall have the option to move to the Open class at any time.

JUNIORS & YOUTHS: Boxers 8 through 17 years of age, who have not yet reached their 18th birthday by the start of the Michigan Golden Gloves Tournament, may participate on a matched bout basis. Pre-matched bouts will be made by tournament staff/officials. Matched bouts may be contested as fill-in bouts throughout the Tournament. Contestants in matched bouts are not eligible for advancement in the tournament.

BOXERS APPEARANCE: As specified in the USA Boxing Official Rule Book. Boxers with infractions of the grooming rules will not be allowed to weigh-in.

UNIFORMS/EQUIPMENT: All participants must provide their own uniforms & mandatory equipment including hand wraps as specified in the USA Boxing Official Rule Book. Coaches must have their own corner equipment. Boxing gloves will be provided. Golden Gloves boxers 139 lbs. or less will wear 10 oz. gloves; boxers over 139 lbs. will wear 12 oz. gloves.

RULES: USA Boxing rules with Golden Gloves rule exceptions will be used in the conducting of this tournament. Additional Golden Gloves policies & procedures as contained in Golden Gloves of America constitution and by-laws shall prevail over this tournament.

MEDICAL BILLS: We are not responsible for medical or dental bills. The limit of your medical and dental coverage is that of those paid by USA Boxing insurance. These expenses will be paid only when the injury is properly reported and the necessary forms are completed in a timely manner. (See USA Boxing for additional information.)

AWARDS: Outstanding awards will be presented to the champion in each weight division of each class. Runner-ups will receive silver medals. **NOTE:** Uncontested champions will receive a gold medal. Each matched bout contestant will receive a momentum for their participation. Special awards will also be presented (Golden Gloves takes pride in presenting the finest awards given anywhere in amateur boxing).
