PLASTIC

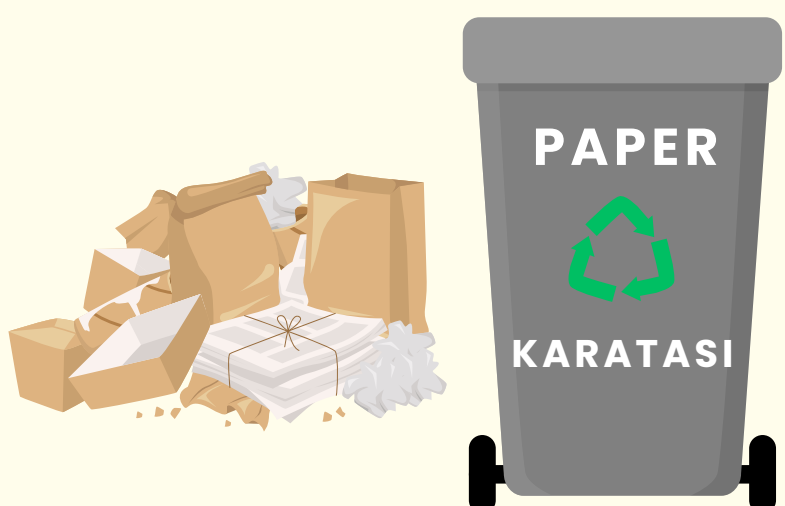


GLASS
