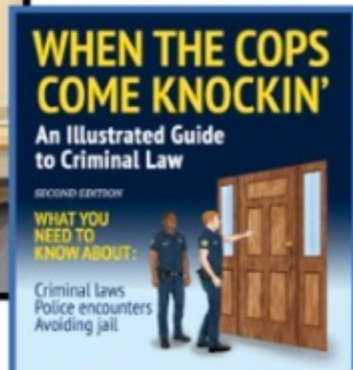

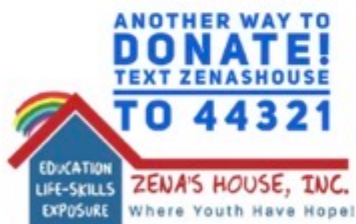

Zena loved school, her family and Friends. Zena died at the age of 17 (2002) due to lupus and its complications.
