We ask for your prayers and continued support as we adjust to our new normal. As you know by now, we were unable to execute any of our planned fundraising activities for 2020. As a result our revenues have suffered. I want to thank those who have remained faithful in their financial support of the church. I am also asking our members who have <u>not</u> remained faithful in their support to prayerfully examine their actions. Even though we have significantly reduced our operating expenses with this move, we need your continuous financial support of the church as we serve God's people.
