

# Batting Cage Rules



- Batters MUST always wear helmets inside tunnels.  
(Renters are responsible to bring their own helmets)
- Pitchers/Machine Operators must wear a helmet inside tunnels at all times.  
(We have Skull cap helmets hanging outside the cage for your use)
- **Only 1 Batter and 1 Pitcher/Machine Operator inside a single tunnel at one time.**
- Only members and users that are older than 18 Years of Age are permitted to operate the pitching machines.
- A waiver must be signed before the use of the equipment by any user who is 18 years of age or older (Parent/guardian must sign for any minors under 18).
- Adults are responsible for the actions of the youth in the training area. Misconduct will result in immediate termination of privileges. Horseplay will not be tolerated.
- No food or drink allowed in the training areas.
- All balls must be returned to their proper bucket or ball caddy after use.
- Batters must wear appropriate shoes. (No Cleats)
- No person under the influence of Drugs or Alcohol is permitted to use the batting cages and will lose any future cage use privileges.
- Alert the trainers/owners immediately and stop usage of pitching machines if the ball flight becomes erratic.
- Balls may be pitched at any time. BE ALERT at all times.
- No one under the age of 6 years old is permitted to use the pitching machines.
- Anyone under the age of 18 must have adult supervision on site.
- The only people swinging a bat are those inside the individual tunnels.
- Do not throw balls back at pitching machines.
- This is a family atmosphere; no profanity or vulgar language/gestures permitted.
- CAUTION! Injuries could result from the use of these devices. Users should assume the inherent risks of batting baseballs and softballs.
