

Batting Cage Rules

- A. Batters MUST wear helmets inside tunnels at all times.
- B. Only members and users that are older than 16 Years of Age are permitted to operate the pitching machines.
- C. A waiver must be signed before use of any of the equipment by any user who is 18 years of age or older (Parent/guardian must sign for any minors).
- D. Adults are responsible for the actions of the youth in the training area. Misconduct will result in immediate termination of privileges. Horse-play/fooling around will not be tolerated.
- E. No food or drink allowed in the training areas.
- F. All balls must be picked up and returned to their proper place after use.
- G. Batters must wear appropriate shoes. (No Cleats)
- H. No person under the influence of Drugs or Alcohol is permitted to use the batting cages.
- I. Alert the trainers/owners immediately and stop usage of pitching machines if the ball flight becomes erratic.
- J. Balls may be pitched at any time. BE ALERT at all times.
- K. No one under the age of 6 years old is permitted to use the pitching machines.
- L. Anyone under the age of 16 must have adult supervision on site. Helmets and bats must be provided by the user.
- M. The only people swinging a bat are those inside the individual tunnels.
- N. Do not throw balls back at pitching machines.
- O. This is a family atmosphere, no profanity or vulgar language/gestures will be permitted.
- P. CAUTION! Injuries could result from the use of these devices. Users should assume the inherent risks of batting baseballs and softballs. If users have any questions about the use of these devices or the inherent risks associated with the use of these devices, ask the attendant before using the batting cages.
