

#### **Boat Ramp Update**

The Boat Ramp project is moving forward. The County was waiting on the Private Dredging Permit to be approved which happened last month. The County received an estimate for the boat ramp replacement and has now applied for a permit to draw down the lake. They are also in the process of requesting bids and gaining County Board approvals. A firm project timeline has not been developed yet.

### **High Speed Internet Update**

Although the Town of Foster was not awarded a grant for the proposed Astrea High Speed Internet project, there has been an opportunity to apply for another grant funded through the American Rescue Plan Act. It requires a Public/Private partnership so the Town of Foster is partnering with Astrea in this latest grant application. Applications were submitted by the end of July and awards are expected to be made this fall. We will keep you notified of any updates through our Facebook page and the next Newsletter.


