

#### \$\$\$ Firewise Funding will be available in 2021 \$\$\$

Unfortunately there weren't any DNR activities allowed for Firewise projects in 2020. We don't know if there will be DNR funding in 2021. Since reducing wildfire risk is a focus of the RDLA, the Lake Association Board had decided that some Bingo Fundraising in 2020 would go to provide matching funds, up to \$500 per homeowner, for projects that reduce Homeowner Ignition Zone Risk. The rules for receiving funds will be the same as they were for the State funding and the DNR team will still do the assessments and determine the projects that make the best use of the funding. More details will be shared via mail in the Spring and at the May meeting.




