

- ✓ Interactive vs Independent vs Supervised toys
  - Interactive means playing directly with your puppy
    - You are the most important part of the game to your puppy. Without your interaction, the toy itself is not important
      - Tug games
      - Fetch
      - Frisbee
      - Flirt Pole
  - Independent means the puppy is unsupervised and alone, possibly in the crate
    - You are not involved in the puppy's interaction with the toy. This is a time to keep the puppy occupied while you are away
      - Stuffed Kong
      - Marrow bone
      - Benebone
  - Supervised means that you are not interacting with the puppy, but watch as your puppy interacts with the toy independently from you
    - You are not involved in your puppy's play, but you are supervising your puppy's interactions, making sure s/he isn't shredding or destroying the toy
      - Rope toy
      - Stuffed or plush toys
      - Puzzle toys
      - Softer rubber toys
      - Jolly balls

  - Marrow bones

  - Jerky style treats
