Monday, February 14, 2022

As Chief of Police/Interim City Manager, I was attending the regularly scheduled Nassau Bay City Council meeting. The meeting was held at the Nassau Bay City Hall, 1800 Space Park Drive, on the second floor of the building and began at 7:00 pm.

During the public comment period of the meeting, Michelle Weller spoke about former City Manager Jason Reynolds. Michelle referenced several pieces of information she had received from open records requests pertaining to Jason's pay related to his separation agreement, his contract with City of Nassau Bay, his contract with the City of Mount Belvieu, and his sick time payout he received.

At about 8:30 pm, after the council meeting was ended, a small group of citizens and several Council members remained in the lobby area and were talking. All city staff, except for myself, had left the building and I asked the group to leave since the building was now closed. Several of them left and a few others, about 5 or 6 remained and continued to talk for another couple of minutes. Councilman Don Matter and citizens Lara Forde and Michelle Weller were in this group. There were at least two others who I did not know with the group.

At this time Jason Reynolds walked into the lobby from the elevator/stairwell area and directly over toward Michelle Weller. Jason walked to about 6 feet away from Michelle and asked her something to the affect of "Here I am if you want to talk shit to my face." Neither Jason nor Michelle moved closer to each other or made contact with the other. At this time, I asked Jason not to cause any problems and to leave. Michelle then asked Jason what was wrong with him and asked him if he was drunk while backing away from him. Jason said he was not drunk. Jason then walked toward the other side of the lobby. I asked Jason to follow me to the police department offices, which are also located on the second floor of City Hall. Jason went with me without any problem. I felt this would diffuse the situation and allow the group of people in the lobby to leave the building without any further confrontation.

Jason and I walked into the police offices and talked for about ten minutes. This allowed Jason to vent and then calm down. Jason did not show any signs of intoxication and there was no smell of alcohol on or about him. Once Jason calmed down, I walked with him to the lobby area and we talked a few minutes more. All the other people had left the building by this time. Jason left the building without any issues. I then left out the rear door and left the property.

Tuesday, February 15, 2022

I reviewed the surveillance video of the City Hall security cameras. I sent an email requesting NBPD Office Manager Tiffany Hatton to preserve the video from Monday, February 14, 2022, 8:30 pm to 8:47 pm for the following cameras: Driveway/Parking, Front Desk, Front Door, NBPD Desk, NBPD Hallway, and Stair/Elevator Landing. This video will be stored in a digital file attached to this case report.

Disposition:
