This release also includes all liability for resulting accidents, damage, injury or illness to myself and my property by any animals owned or cared for by Lazy Dog Ranch, Cheryl Pitzer or Peter Pitzer Jr. I also understand that under Texas law Chapter 87, civil practice and remedies code, farm professionals are not liable for an injury or death of a participant in farm animal activities, resulting from their inherent risks associated with animals.

When mounted on any animal, I agree to wear appropriate clothing including protective gear approved for equestrian activities. Riders under 18 must wear ASTM approved headgear with harness secured. When jumping obstacles all riders must wear ASTM approved headgear with harness secured. In addition, while jumping solid cross country style obstacles riders must wear a protective vest. Both headgear and vest must meet all standards imposed by the current USEF rules for eventing.

I understand the owners and organizers of any event have the right to refuse entry; as well as stop or prohibit any actions deemed improper, unsafe, or cruel. I certify I have read the Lazy Dog Ranch rules and agree to adhere to them. I understand that my image may be captured on video, film or audio; and those images may be used in promotional materials. In addition, I also understand Lazy Dog Ranch property is protected by video and photo surveillance, which will be used in legal proceedings of criminal or civil activities.

LAZY DOG RANCH FACILITY RULES

All activities are at your own risk. A liability release must be signed immediately upon arrival for everyone entering property.

All equine must have proof of negative coggins test within 12 months.

Dogs must be leashed at all times.

No smoking around barn area.

Do not approach or touch any Lazy Dog Ranch animals without permission.

Do not ride, graze or lunge horses in front yard of house.

Do not allow animals to drink from pasture troughs. Water for drinking buckets and washing is available in east pasture, and in front of barn office.

Manure from stalls may be dumped in spreader at west end of barn.

Riders must wear appropriate clothing and protective gear including shoes with heels. Riders under 18 must wear ASTM approved headgear with harness secured whenever mounted. When jumping, all riders must wear ASTM headgear with harness secured. When jumping solid obstacles, riders must also wear a protective vest. Headgear and vests must meet current standards imposed by the USEF rules for eventing.

Jumping is only allowed under trainer supervision.

Entrance and use of all pastures, barn, and equipment (except covered arena) is by appointment only. Use of covered arena without appointment allowed by specific agreement only.

Covered arena policies:

Please turn off lights when leaving. Please do not turn light switch on then off quickly – the lights may be damaged. The lights may take as long as 5 minutes to fully illuminate.

Make sure property gates are fully closed at all times.

Return any equipment (like jumps) to position you found them in when finished.

Emergency information located in box at north gate of arena.

Tie animals only to tie rings, not to support columns.
