- WHO SHOULD ATTEND; Any resident of North Dakota who wants to get a concealed carry permit for firearms or dangerous weapons.
- WHAT WILL BE OFFERED; Classroom training for class
   1 & class 2 ND CCWP and live fire testing for class 1
   requirements.
- WHERE IS IT GOING TO BE; Williston Rifle and Pistol Club in the Spring Lake Park (directly across from the Dog Park area)
- WHAT DO I HAVE TO DO; All written test materials will be provided, the test is open book. A PowerPoint presentation will be given and a question& answer session before the test. If a class one license is desired a live fire proficiency test will be done at the indoor facility.
- WHAT DO I NEED TO BRING WITH ME: A valid
  North Dakota I.D. to verify residency. For the live fire portion
  of the class 1 test it is recommended to have 150 rounds of
  ammunition for the weapon you will be testing with. A
  weapon/magazine holster that affixes to your belt and 2
  feeding or speed loading devices.
