

VOTING PROCESS FOR RESTATED INDENTURE AND BYLAWS
JUNE 5, 2018

All vote counting will be performed by an independent 3rd party, the accounting firm of Mengwasser Martin Lall & Clark P.C. Stan Mengwasser, Trails West trustee and president, was a partner of this firm. He retired 3 years ago and has no financial interest in the firm.

Each property owner in the Village of Green Trails should have a ballot included in his/her packet. After reading the proposal and making a decision, you may cast your ballot by mail or in person. First, please fill in the **date** and the **Village property address** at the top of the ballot. **Sign** your ballot and **mark** your choice with an X.

The ballot is addressed to the accounting firm and postage is paid. You may enter your mailing return address in the corner and drop it in the mail. If you prefer to cast your ballot in person, the trustees will be at Chesterfield City Hall, Room 101, from 7 to 9 pm on July 18 with a locked box into which you may drop your ballot. The box will be returned to the accounting firm as they have the key. The firm will record the yes/no votes and separately record addresses of all owners that voted either by mail or in person. This locked ballot box will also be available at the August trustee meeting if you prefer more time to go over the proposal.
