
Dear Mr. Lambrecht:

I am writing you on behalf of the Village of Green Trails Association, Inc. in response to your Notice of Violation for Failure to Maintain Private Stormwater Management Facilities dated August 21, 2020.

As required by #1 in your Notice, the 10 inch standpipe inside the basin's detention control system is being repaired and the lake is lowering. A portion of the pipe cracked and had to be removed. It was discovered that the 10 foot pipe section into the lake was clogged with logs. When the clog broke loose, the rushing water prevented proper placement of the new pipe. So the lake is now lower than necessary and when the water pressure lessens, the pipe will be reattached at the appropriate height. We will inform MSD when this is completed.

Hiring a contractor to repair the spillway, as required by #2 in your Notice, who can get us on the schedule this year without a significant price hike has been difficult. The company we selected is DJM Ecological Services and the contact between the Village of Green Trails Association and DJM Ecological Services, Inc. is attached. DJM has the final engineering plans from the project completed by Clayton Engineering in 2008 and will make the repairs accordingly. Larger rock will be added. DJM will begin the work towards the end of November, hopefully to finish by year's end, 12/31/2020 weather permitting.
