- 2. Biblically literate
- 3. Relationally connected to the church
- 4. Living sacrificially through generosity and service
- 5. Actively discipling others

Example #2

Vision Statement

Love God, Love Others

Mission Statement

We love God through obedience to His Word and His Son. We love others through building meaningful relationships with the community for Christ.

Draft of Vision Statements given from HHMC Group Work

- To build a community focused on God.
- A community in an active relationship with Jesus Christ.
- Followers of Christ that gather, grow, and go.

Draft of Mission Statements given from HHMC Group Work

- Love, learn, grow, and witness
- Believers committed to making followers of Jesus Christ, who seek to serve our community, growing in faith, building relationships, and discovering our gifts.
- 3 part:
 - o Gather through outward evangelism in community through actions and activities
 - o Grow membership through baptism, teaching, and obedience.
 - o Go into the world to spread the Word of Jesus Christ through witness.
- To create a Christian experience for all people that encourages a relationship with Christ.
