#### From the Pastor

Dear Church,

During our worship service on Sunday, March 16, we reflected on Paul's words to Timothy, reminding us of God's all-encompassing love. This love compels us to invite others into a living relationship with Jesus Christ.

I challenged our congregation to invite one new person to church each week for the rest of the year. With 40 Sundays remaining and an average weekly attendance of 87, this commitment could lead to 3,480 invitations by year's end. If just 10% of those invited begin attending regularly, we would welcome 348 people for whom God deeply loves into our faith community—more than a 400% increase of our weekly average attendance!

This kind of exponential growth mirrors the movement of the Holy Spirit in the early church, as recorded in Acts. It is not simply our work, but the Spirit's power that transforms hearts. May we embrace this challenge with faith and dedication, for the glory of God!



**P.S.** On May 3 and 10 you have an opportunity to attend the International Leadership Institute's History Makers training at Foundation Methodist Church in Temple.
