The focus of the show is to demonstrate just how great the Blood Bowl Sevens rules variant really is

– and how much variety and fun can be had playing it!

Season 1 Rules and Structure

We're using the standard Blood Bowl Sevens rules from the NAF website: https://www.thenaf.net/wp-content/uploads/2019/09/Blood-Bowl-Sevens-2019.pdf
Season 1 features 5 Teams, playing against each other over a period of 5 Rounds.

Once the Regular Season (5 games) has happened, the top 4 teams will go into a single-elimination Semi-Final and then Final.

For Season 1 we are not tracking SPPs or Cash, and it is resurrection format (so no injuries).

Team Building Rules

The Teams are built using the rules as above, however we're adding in some skills to spice things up.

Each Coach can choose 1 Skill when building the Team.

After every game the Coach can choose 1 Skill for a Player.

Skills have no stacking limit, and the type of Skill (Normal / Double) allowed is dependant on the tier of the team as listed below.

Team Building Rules

The Teams are built using the rules as above, however we're adding in some skills to spice things up.

Each Coach can choose 1 Skill when building the Team.

After every game the Coach can choose 1 Skill for a Player.

Skills have no stacking limit, and the type of Skill (Normal / Double) allowed is dependant on the tier of the team as listed below.

1	Chaos Dwarf, Dwarf, Wood Elves, Skaven, Norse, Lizardmen, Orc, Undead, Amazon, Dark Elves			
2	Chaos, Human, Khemri, Pact, Slann, High Elves, Nurgle, Necromantic, Pro Elves, Vampires, Underworld			
3	Halflings, Goblins, Ogres			

Skills

As described above Players can receive additional Skills throughout the Season. The type of Skill allowed (Single / Double) depends on the Team's Tier.
