# It's Getting Busy Again!

At our Board meeting on November 9<sup>th</sup>, we heard from structural engineer Chris Essepi about fixing the **foundation** of the old BOE building. He suggests that we move the structure temporarily and drive helical pilings down about 15-feet before restoring it to its original place. We also discussed **demolition** of the 1950s addition which should happen first.

**Architects MHK** presented renderings of their ideas for the visitor center downstairs and detailed plans for both floors. They will be coordinating with the engineers so that we can plan our progress in making BOE useful feature in our little city, the birthplace of Collier County.
