2021 Measure A
Canvass results, January 4, 2022

Dear Board of Directors,

Attached please find true and correct information concerning the canvass results of Measure A, Kelseyville Fire Protection District, as of the close of canvass on January 4, 2022.

MK Elections mailed ballots to 7289 voters on November 8, 2021, based on data received from the Lake County Registrar of Voters. Due to a data processing error on our part, 1177 ballots were sent to addresses of registration rather than mailing addresses such as post office boxes. As a result, these 1177 ballots were re-sent on November 18. In addition, voters were added twice: (1) Three voters were added under the rubric "Confidential Voters 1, 2, and 3" at the request of the Registrar of Voters. The legal status of these three voters and their ballots is guaranteed by the Registrar of Voters. (2) On December 7, 2021, MK Elections received an updated list of qualified voters from the Registrar of Voters. As a result of that list, 50 additional voters were added to the list of qualified voters, and were sent ballots. As a result, 7342 voters were qualified to vote in the election.

During the open period of the election, the ballots were returned to a post box in Kelseyville, CA where they were picked up by representatives of the district. A ballot box was also available for voters to drop off ballots at the district's office. The ballots were signature matched by the Registrar of Voters, and then remained in the custody of the District until they were provided to our canvassing board at 7:45 AM on December 22, 2021. At this time a small number of ballots remained with the District and the Registrar.

During the open period of the election, MK Elections tracked the return of undeliverable ballots. Likewise, we mailed replacement ballots to voters upon their filling out the attestation required under state law. Voters were able to call a hotline maintained by MK Elections to obtain the necessary form. MK Elections has maintained all returned forms and all calls to the hotline as part of the election record. Complete information about voters, undeliverables, replacement ballots sent, and other details of the mailing process is attached to this letter and available in the paper and electronic records that accompany this report.

On December 22, MK Elections authenticated the ballots and ensured that no voter had returned more than one ballot. We posted the list of accepted ballots, as required by law, and then performed the canvass of the accepted ballots by manual tally in accordance with the California Election Code.

The results of this tally as of the close of the canvass on December 22 were prepared for the district and certified at that time.

As of the end of the day on December 22, approximately 150 ballots remained at large for the purpose of curing either (1) because they have not yet been signature matched by the Registrar of Voters, or (2) they lack the required signature on the return envelope or (3) because their signature does not, according to the Registrar of Voters, match the one on file for their voter record. MK Elections returned to Kelseyville and reopened the canvass on January 4, 2022 to complete the tally and provide final certification of the count. Attached below are the final results of the canvas following the return and completion of the canvass.
